#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics finish the month of April with a 16-12 record...it marks just the second time over the last 10 years the A's have posted a winning record in April (16-11 in 2008)...set Athletics records for most runs (168), doubles (66), extra base hits (100) and walks (130) in April.
- The A's are 13-2 (.867) against American League West competition and 3-10 (.231) against everyone else (2-8 vs. East, 1-2 vs. Central)...lost the first two games of the season to Seattle but have won 13 straight against Western division foes since then...that is tied for the A's longest winning streak against the West since divisional play began in 1969...also won 13 straight June 12-August 11, 1994.
- The A's have scored at least four runs in all five of their games against Los Angeles this year...are now 22-0 against the Angels over the last three years when scoring four or more runs.
- Jarrod Parker** earned his first win of the season...the win snapped his season-opening four-game losing streak, which was the longest of his career...the four losses match the most in Oakland history by a pitcher in the month of April (12<sup>th</sup> time).
- Yoenis Cespedes** (2 for 4, r, 2b, 3b, 4 rbi) recorded his first career four RBI game...was reinstated from the DL Sunday...the A's have won each of the three games since his return and are 11-2 (.846) with him in the starting lineup compared to 5-10 (.333) in games he doesn't start.
- Seth Smith** (2 for 4, r, 2b, 3 rbi, ibb, so) hit a three-run double in the sixth inning...the three RBI match his season-high (third time).

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are on a four-game losing streak, which is one short of their season long of five (April 7-12)...finish the month of April with a 9-17 record and are now 17-32 in April over the past two years...are 3-11 on the road compared to 6-6 at home...are 1-5 on this seven-game road trip to Seattle (1-3) and Oakland (0-2).
- The Angels are 0-5 against Oakland for first the first time since 1990 when they also started 0-5 against the A's.
- Garrett Richards** allowed a season-high seven runs (previous: 5, April 25 at Seattle)...is 1-2 with a 5.54 ERA (16 er in 26.0 ip) in four games as a starter compared to 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA (1 er in 4.1 ip) in two relief appearances.
- J.B. Shuck** (2 for 3, 2 r) recorded his first multiple hit game of the season...it is the fifth of his career, his first Sept. 23, 2011 vs. Colorado.
- Mike Trout** (2 for 4, r, 2b, 3b, 4 rbi, bb) recorded a season-high tying four RBI (also: April 20 vs. Detroit)...it is his fifth career game of four or more RBI...now has 14 RBI in his last 13 games after tallying two RBI over the first 13 games.
- Mark Trumbo** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi bb, so) has reached base safely in 25 of the Angels 26 games...has at least one hit in 22 of those contests.
