LEADING OFF: Tonight, the Angels play the sixth game (1-4) of a seven-day, seven-game road trip to Seattle (April 25-28; 1-3) and Oakland (April 29-May 1; 0-1)...Angels' 9-16 mark after 25 games is tied for worst mark in club history (5th time, last, 1994)...Halos have dropped seven of last eight road games...LAA is 7-8 in last 15 contests but has dropped six of last eight games overall...Club is 5-12 vs. A.L. West foes...2013 represents the Angels' 53rd season in the Majors and 48th campaign in Anaheim.

OAKTOWN MARATHON: Yesterday, the Angels fell to the Oakland A's in 19 innings on a Brandon Moss walk-off HR...At 6 hours and 32 minutes, last night's contest was the longest game in Angels history, surpassing the 6 hour and 6 minute affair played on April 13, 1982 vs. Seattle (20 innings)...Innings-wise, last night's contest was the third longest game in Angels history (20 innings, twice, 4/13/82 vs. SEA & 7/9/71 @ OAK)...Yesterday was the longest MLB game since the Pirates beat the Cardinals, 6-3, in 19 innings on August 19, 2012 in St. Louis and the longest American League game since the White Sox beat the Red Sox, 6-5, in 19 innings on July 9, 2006 in Chicago...Two of three games of at least 19 innings in Angels history have been walk-off losses to A's...18 total runs scored were the fourth-most in 19-inning MLB history...Angels slipped to 3-1 in extra inning games this season...Two clubs used a combined 16 pitchers (eight each)...LAA and Oakland pitchers combined to throw a total of 597 pitches (Angels, 297 pitches, 185 strikes; A's, 300 pitches, 188 strikes)...Angels pitchers tossed 297 pitches, the team's most since at least 1988...Eight pitchers used by the Angels were the most since nine pitchers appeared on 4/9/11 vs. Toronto.

MARATHON PART II: Howie Kendrick and Brendan Harris both went 2-for-9, becoming the second and third Angels logging nine at-bats in a game (Don Baylor, 5-for-9, 4/13/82 vs. SEA)...They joined Oakland's Jed Lowrie as the first American League players with nine at-bats since Boston's Trot Nixon on 7/9/06 vs. CHW...Last night was the first game in nearly two decades with at least three players to log at least nine at-bats (8/31/93 CLE @ MIN)...Six different Halo hurlers allowed a run for the fifth time in Angels history (last, 9/30/2000)...Tommy Hanson and Jerome Williams each tossed six innings...Michael Kohn fired two scoreless frames...Albert Pujols launched two HRs and posted his 40th career four-hit game (third since joining Angels)...Mark Trumbo went 3-for-8, including an estimated 475-foot blast, tied for the longest in MLB this season according to ESPN...Seven of the Angels' nine position players went the full 19 frames...All told offensively, the Angels finished 15-for-70 with three homers, six walks and 18 strikeouts...Four players left last night's game due to injury (Peter Bourjos, hamstring; Luis Jimenez, shin; Coco Crisp, hamstring; Chris Young, quad).

SCHEDULING UPDATE: Yesterday the Angels and FOX Sports West announced two changes to the schedule this week: Today's (4/30) Angels @ Athletics game and Friday's (5/3) Angels vs. Orioles game will both be televised on KCOP-TV (My13). Coverage for both broadcasts will begin with "Angels Live" at 6:30pm PT.

@ OAKLAND: In last meeting, Angels were swept at home by A's for first time since Oct. 4-7, 2001...Angels are 0-4 against A's for first time since starting 0-5 against Oakland in 1990...Two of the three longest games in Angels history have come against the A's (last night, 19 innings; 7/9/71, 20 innings)...A's claimed 2012 season series 10-9 with the Halos dropping seven of 10 contests at Angel Stadium against Oakland...Halos have lost three straight season series vs. A's...Angels trail all-time series vs. OAK, 390-439 with a 206-211 all-time mark at home...Halos are 9-10 in last 19 games in Oakland, winning eight of last 12 games here.

HURTIN' HALOS: Today, the Angels placed Peter Bourjos (left hamstring strain) on the 15-day disabled list and activated INF Erick Aybar from the D.L...LAA now has seven players (four pitchers) on the 15-day D.L...Angels have used 18 pitchers this month, the most in any month since August, 2000 and the most the Halos have ever used in April.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER – RHP GARRETT RICHARDS

1-1, 3.65 ERA

First career start at O.co Coliseum

- Makes fourth start of the season today and second road start of the year after making first four appearances of 2013 and final 20 appearances of 2012 out of the bullpen.
- **LAST TIME OUT:** Took first loss of the season on Thursday at Seattle, after allowing a season-high five earned runs and nine hits across seven innings while striking out five.
- In four relief appearances this season, allowed one run on three hits with five strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched (2.08 ERA)...Recorded at least one strikeout in each outing, and did not allow a run in three of four games played.
- **VS. OAKLAND:** Has made three career relief appearances against the A's (all in 2012) and did not allow a run in 2.2 innings of work while striking out four and walking two.
- **AT O.CO COLISEUM:** In two career relief appearances at the Coliseum, has pitched 1.1 shutout innings allowing two hits and a walk with three strikeouts.
- Has pitched at least 6.1 innings in each of his three starts this season and is the only Angels starter with three games tossing more than six innings.
- Is holding opposing hitters to a .193 (17/88) clip this season and a .197 (14/71) average as a starter.

2012 RECAP:

- Appeared in 30 games with Angels (nine starts) and 14 games (all starts) at triple-A Salt Lake...With Angels finished 4-3 with one save and a 4.69 ERA (71 IP – 37 ER)...Went 3-2 as a starter with a 4.42 ERA as a starter and 1-1 with a 5.50 ERA as a reliever.
- Angels went 6-3 in his nine starts, including a 4-1 mark at the Big A...Allowed three runs-or-less in five of nine starts – Halos went 5-0 in those outings...In his 30 overall appearances, LAA went 22-8.
- Tossed a career-best eight shutout innings, June 17th vs. Arizona, three outs shy of becoming first Angels' rookie to throw a complete game shutout since Ervin Santana in 2005.
- Recorded first career victory on June 5th vs. Seattle...Earned first career save on August 24 vs. Detroit.

- Has compiled a career 5-6 record with a 4.60 ERA (109.2 IP – 56 ER) and 75 strikeouts in 44 career big league appearances.
