OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their three-game winning streak snapped...are now 4-9 over the last 13 games after starting the season 12-4.
- The A's had their 13-game winning streak against American League West competition snapped...the streak tied the Oakland record for longest intra-division winning streak (June 12-August 11, 1994).
- The A's scored four runs today and lost...entering today, the A's were 22-0 against the Angels over the last three years when scoring four or more runs.
- The A's played a combined 13 hours and 46 minutes in three games this series...it is the longest three-game series in Oakland history (previous: 12 hours and 30 minutes, September 21-23, 2013 at New York-AL).
- Tommy Milone** recorded a career-high tying 10 strikeouts (third time, last: Sept. 9, 2012 at Seattle) in a season-high tying seven innings (also: April 3 vs. Seattle)...did not allow a walk...has walked six batters in six starts and 39.0 innings, an average of 1.38 per nine innings...has 36 strikeouts for a strikeout to walk ratio of 6.00...has lost each of his last three starts after recording the win in his first three starts.
- Luke Montz** (1 for 4, r, 2b, rbi) was selected from Triple-A Sacramento today and made his A's debut...it was his first appearance in a Major League game since September 28, 2008 at Philadelphia while playing for Washington.
- Josh Reddick** (1 for 2, r, 3 bb) snapped his 0 for 15 streak with a single in the second inning...walked three times, his first career three-walk game.
- Adam Rosales** (3 for 4, 2b, rbi, so) recorded a season-high three hits...it is his ninth career game of three or more hits, his first since July 17, 2010 at Kansas City.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels snapped their four-game losing streak...the streak was one short of their season-long of five (April 7-12)...are 10-17 after 27 games, which matches their start from last year.
- The Angels allowed four runs today, snapping a streak of five straight games in which they yielded eight or more runs to Oakland...it is just the second time the Angels have allowed eight runs in five consecutive games against a single opponent (also: Sept. 4-12, 1979 vs. Chicago-AL).
- C.J. Wilson** allowed a season-high five walks (previous: 4, three times)...tossed 36 pitches in the first inning...tossed 43 pitches in the first the last time he faced Oakland April 9...is 8-7 with a 3.65 ERA (48 er in 118.1 ip) in 43 career games against the A's, including 14 starts.
- Howie Kendrick** (3 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) had a season-high tying three hits (fourth time)...has hit safely in 12 of his past 13 games and is batting .333 (18 for 54) with six runs, two doubles, three home runs and nine RBI over that span...is 13 for 29 (.448) against Oakland this year.
- Mark Trumbo** (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, bb 2 so) has hit a home run in three straight games, the fourth time in his career he has homered in three or more consecutive games...has reached base safely in 26 of the Angels 27 games...has at least one hit in 23 of those contests.
