OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their two-game losing streak...are now 3-3 over the past six games after losing a season-high five straight....are 2-2 on this six-game homestand against Texas (1-2) and Kansas City (1-0).
- Jarrod Parker tossed a season-high 7.0 innings (previous: 6.1, twice)...is 2-1 with a 4.07 ERA (11 er in 24.1 ip) over his last four starts after going 0-4 with an 8.10 ERA over his first five starts.
- Grant Balfour has converted each of his last 25 save opportunities, which is the third longest streak in Oakland history...his last blown save came on April 29, 2012 at Baltimore.
- Sean Doolittle recorded his third win of the season, which is a new career-high...has not allowed a run in his last nine games and 8.1 innings.
- Josh Donaldson (2 for 3, r, hr, rbi) extended his hitting streak to a career-high tying six games (11 for 23, .478)...is now batting .384 (33 for 86) with 11 doubles, four home runs, 18 RBI and 14 walks over his last 24 games.
- Adam Rosales (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so) hit a go-ahead solo home run in the eighth inning...is now batting .314 (16 for 51) over his last 16 games after going 1 for 6 over his first three contests.

KANSAS CITY NOTES

- The Kansas City Royals have lost eight of the past 11 games after winning a season-high tying four straight...are 2-2 on this nine-game road trip to Los Angeles (2-1), Oakland (0-1) and Houston (three games).
- James Shields tossed the 21st complete game of his career...recorded a season-high tying nine strikeouts (second time)...is 0-2 with a 1.50 ERA (4 er in 24.0 ip) in three starts in the month of May after going 2-2 with a 3.00 ERA in six April starts.
- Lorenzo Cain (0 for 1, 2 bb) had a career-high tying two walks (also: August 5, 2012 vs. Texas).
- Alex Gordon (1 for 4, 2 so) is 13 for 32 (.406) with five runs, three doubles and five RBI in eight games since moving to the number three spot in the batting order May 9.
- Eric Hosmer (1 for 4, so, cs) snapped his 0 for 10 streak with a single in the second inning... is a .328 (21 for 64) career hitter against Oakland.
- David Lough (2 for 4, 2b, rbi) was recalled today from Triple-A Omaha... had a career-high tying two hits (fourth time).
- Salvador Perez (1 for 3, r, 2b) is on an eight-game hitting streak (12 for 31, .387).
