#### SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS MEDIA NOTES San Francisco Giants (28-23) at Oakland Athletics (29-23)

May 28, 2013 O.co Coliseum

TONIGHT'S GAME...The Giants visit their cross-bay rival, the Oakland Athletics tonight in the second of this four-game series that features two games here in Oakland and then two in San Francisco (Wed.-Thurs.), part of MLB's new home-and-home series format for "prime rival" Interleague games...RHP Jarrod Parker (2-6, 5.76) will face LHP Michael Kickham (ML debut).

THE GIANTS...Dropped a 4-1 decision to the Athletics yesterday and have now lost six of their last seven road contests...they enter tonight's game in second place in the NL West, 1.5 games back of first-place Arizona.

<u>TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES...</u>Prior to tonight's game the Giants have purchased the contract LHP Michael Kickham from triple-A Fresno...to make room for Kickham, SF transferred LHP Eric Surkamp to the 60-day disabled list...following yesterday's game the Giants optioned RHP Sandy Rosario to triple-A.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS...LHP Michael Kickham (#59) will make his big league debut tonight, starting in place of RHP Ryan Vogelsong, who fractured his right hand last week...Kickham will be the second Giants player to make his ML debut this season, joining Nick Noonan.

MORE ABOUT THE KID...Kickham, 24, has gone 3-4 with a 4.33 ERA (26er, 54.0ip) in 10 starts for the triple-A Fresno Grizzlies this season...he was 0-3 with a 7.94 figure (20er, 22.2ip) in his first five starts, but has gone 3-1 with a 1.72 ERA (6er, 31.1ip) in his past five assignments...he will become the first player from the Giants' 2010 draft class to reach the Majors, as he was drafted in the sixth round that year by SF.

<u>FALLING BEHIND</u>...The Giants have allowed their opponent to score first in their last six games and seven of their last eight contests...<u>SF</u> is just 10-15 in games when they fall behind, compared to 18-8 when they score first.

ROUGH STARTS...Giants starters' have posted a 5.86 ERA (84er, 129.0ip) on the road this season, which ranks as the highest in the NL and fourth-highest in the Majors ahead of Minnestoa (6.20), Houston (6.14) and Toronto (6.10).

TO THE RESCUE...The Giants bullpen leads the Majors with a 2.74 ERA (47er, 154.1ip) this season...their 12 relief wins are tied with Cincinnati for the most in the bigs.

**ROAD WOES**...The Giants are just 9-14 (.391) on the road this season, losing their last four road contests and six of their last seven...in fact, the Giants have lost 12 of their past 16 road games and have won just three road series all year.

**INSIDE THE SERIES**...San Francisco has dropped six of the last 10 meetings vs. Oakland and are just 19-28 here at O.co Coliseum, dropping eight of their last 10 games here.

<u>LEADING THE WAY...IF Brandon Crawford</u> has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 games, batting .353 (24-for-68) during the stretch...<u>Crawford ranks second among NL shortstops with 29 RBI, third with a .286 avg. and has the fourth-most extra base hits (18).</u>

RISPY BUSINESS...The Giants have struggled with runners in scoring position over their last nine games, batting .200 (16-for-80)...SF still ranks second in the NL, hitting at a .283 clip (126-for-446) in these situations.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY... The Giants are 0-3 in Interleague play this season... besides the A's, the Giants play the Blue Jays, Rays, Orioles, Red Sox and Yankees in the AL this year... SF went 7-8 in Interleague last season and have gone 130-127 (.506) overall in Interleague since it began in 1997.

<u>WITH THE BATS</u>... The Giants' offense enters tonight's game leading the National League with a .269 batting avg. (470-for-1,747)... the Giants are also averaging 4.49 runs per game, the fourth-highest figure in the NL.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD...The Giants are in a stretch in which they play 13 of their next 17 games on the road, with visits to teams with four of the top five records in the National League: the Cardinals (33-17, .660), Pirates (31-20, .606), Braves (30-20, .600) and Dbacks (30-22, .577)...23 of the Giants' next 34 games are on the road.

#### TONIGHT'S OUTING

- 24-year-old left-hander will be making his Major League debut tonight, taking the place of Ryan Vogelsong in the starting rotation as Vogelsong is on the disabled list with a fractured right hand.
- Has made 10 starts for triple-A Fresno this season and has gone 3-4 with a 4.33 ERA (26er, 54.0ip).
- Battled in five April starts, going 0-3 with a 7.94 ERA (20er, 22.2ip)...however, has rebounded in May posting a 3-1 mark with a 1.72 ERA (6er, 31.1ip) and 29 strikeouts in five outings.
- Prior to being called-up, was tied for fifth in the PCL with 54 strikeouts... was striking out 9.0 batters per 9.0 innings pitched.
- Struggled on the road with Fresno posting a 1-3 mark with a 7.03 ERA (19er, 24.1ip) in five outings...in comparison, went 2-1 with a 2.12 ERA (7er, 29.2ip) in five home starts.
- Issued just nine walks in his last six outings after surrendering 13 free passes in his first four starts this season.
- Was a non-roster invitee to Giants camp this year...appeared in three games this spring and allowed three runs on six hits and three walks with one strikeout in 4.1 innings.

#### **2013 STARTS (LAST THREE AT FRESNO)**

- Earned his third-consecutive win in his last start on Thursday in Fresno's 4-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits and three walks in 6.1 innings, while striking out four batters.
- Won his second-straight start after holding New Orleans to one unearned run in 6.0 innings on May 18...matched his season-high for strikeouts with eight...surrendered just four hits, which also matched his season-low for a start.
- Earned his first victory of the season on May 13 in Fresno's 4-3 win at Memphis...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on six hits and three walks with two strikeouts.

#### MINOR LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Owns a 19-24 record in four minor league seasons with a 4.52 ERA (131er, 318.2ip) is 62 outings (58 starts).
- Was named to the postseason Eastern League All-Star team in 2012... finished fourth in the EL in ERA (3.05) and second in strikeouts (137)... opponents hit just .216 against him (second-lowest figure in the league).

#### **COLLEGIATE CAREER**

- Was drafted by the Giants in sixth round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft out of Missouri State.
- Won the Dave Dickensheet Pitcher of the Year Award in 2010 at Missouri State, where he holds the single-season strikeout record with 103 punchouts that season.

#### TOMORROW'S STARTER: Tim Lincecum

- Is 3-4 with a 4.75 ERA (32er, 60.2ip) in 10 starts this season, with just three of those being quality outings...has lost four of his last five decisions, allowing 22 earned runs in 38.0 innings (5.21)...Took the loss in his previous outing last Friday vs. Colorado in SF's 5-0 defeat...tossed 7.0 innings, allowing four earned runs on seven hits and two walks with eight strikeouts.
- <u>vs. Oakland</u>: Is scheduled to make his 10th career start against the Athletics...is 5-2 with a 2.17 ERA (15er, 62.1ip) and three complete games (two shutouts) in his first nine outings...made two starts last season vs. Oakland, going 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7er, 10.0ip).
