OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their fourth "walk-off" win of the season...are now 9-1 in games decided in the last at-bat, and 4-1 in extrainning games...have won eight of the last nine games and 13 of the last 15...have a seven-game home winning streak, which is the longest home winning streak by an A's team since a 10-game streak from Aug. 11-Sept. 1, 2006.
- Dan Straily is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (2 er in 19.0 ip) over his last three starts after going 1-2 with a 7.27 ERA over his first five starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes (2 for 5, 2b, rbi, ibb, so) is batting .339 (19 for 56) during the day compared to .174 (20 for 115) at night...of his 39 hits this year, 19 are for extra bases (eight doubles, two triples, nine home runs).
- Josh Donaldson (2 for 5, r, bb, so) is 13 for 31 (.419) with two doubles, two home runs and five RBI over his last seven games...is now batting .362 (50 for 138) with 15 doubles, six home runs and 25 RBI over his last 38 contests.
- Nate Freiman (1 for 3, rbi, 3b, bb) hit an RBI triple in the fifth inning, his first career triple.
- Jed Lowrie (4 for 5, r, 2b, bb) recorded his fourth career four-hit game (last: April 19, 2013 at Tampa Bay)...is 10 for 27 (.370) with five walks over his last seven games after missing three games with a right foot contusion.
- Chris Young (3 for 6, r, rbi, 2 2b, so) snapped his 0 for 19 streak with an rbi single in the second inning.

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five straight games, which matches their season-high losing streak (April 9-13)...are 0-4 on this eight game road trip to Chicago (0-2), Oakland (0-2), and Seattle (three games).
- Jose Quintana is 1-0 with a 4.70 ERA (8 er in 15.1 ip) in three day games compared to 2-2 with a 3.59 ERA (19 er in 47.2 ip) in eight night
- Jesse Crain is on a new career-high 20.1 scoreless innings streak after tossing a scoreless eighth inning (previous: 20.0 ip)...also set a new career high in consecutive scoreless appearances in today's game with his 22nd
- Jeff Keppinger (2 for 4, so, r) is 17 for 44 (.386) in his last 13 games and .281 (32-114) over his last 30 contests.
- Paul Konerko (0 for 2, 2 so) left the game in the sixth inning with a stiff neck.
