OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 39-27 for the season... it is their best record after 66 games since 1992 when they were also 39-27...have won eight of the last 11 games, 14 of the last 18, and 19 of the last 24.
- Bartolo Colon is 5-0 with a 0.75 ERA (3 er in 36.0 ip) with no homers allowed over his last five starts...allowed four walks, the first time he has allowed four walks in a game since July 7, 2011 vs. Tampa Bay.
- Grant Balfour is a perfect 16 for 16 in save opportunities and has converted each of his last 34 save chances...is now the only American League closer without a blown save...that is the longest season-opening streak without a blown save by an A's pitcher since Dennis Eckersley set the record by converting each of his first 36 saves in 1992.
- Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 1) left the game in the third inning with left hamstring tightness and is day to day.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) hit a leadoff home run in the first inning...it was his third leadoff home run of the season, the 11th of his career including nine with the Athletics...the home run was his first at the Coliseum this season after a streak of seven on the road.
- Nate Freiman (3 for 4, r) had a career-high tying three hits...both career three-hit games have been against the Yankees...has hit safely in all three of his games against New York this year...is batting .344 (21 for 61) since May 1 after hitting .148 in April.
- Derek Norris (2 for 3, r, 2b, hr, 4 rbi) recorded his first career four-RBI game.

- The New York Yankees are now 3-2 on this 10-game road trip to Seattle (3-1), Oakland (0-1), and Los Angeles (0-0).
- CC Sabathia tossed his 1000th career inning as a Yankee in the 6th inning...is 2-2 with a 5.55 ERA (22 er in 35.2 ip) over his last five starts...
- Robinson Cano (2 for 3, r, 2b, 2 bb) is batting .265 (43 for 162) at night compared to .299 (26 for 87) during the day.
- Brett Gardner (2 for 5, r, so) has hit safely in 16 of his past 18 games, batting .365 (25 for 68) with three home runs 11 RBI during that span.
- Travis Hafner (0 for 3, 2 bb) is five for his last 40 (.125).
- Chris Stewart (2 for 4, so) is 5 for 14 (.357) on the road trip.
