FINALES: The Yankees are 12-10 in series finales this season...are 6-5 in finales on the road, winning four of the last seven.

RHP Hiroki Kuroda, 38, will make his 14th start of the season today vs. the Oakland Athletics at O.co Colisuem...will be his fourth career start vs. Oakland and first this season...**last started** on 6/7 at Seattle and recorded the loss in the 4-1 Yankees' defeat, allowing 4ER on 8H in 6.1IP (3BB, 6K, 1WP)...dropped to 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA (33.0IP, 12ER) in five career starts vs. the Mariners...allowed 4ER or more for just the second time in 13 starts this season...signed a one-year contract with the Yankees on 11/20/12.
