### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics had their 11 game home winning streak snapped, which is the third longest home winning streak in Oakland history and the longest since Aug. 13-Sept. 14, 2002 when they won 12 straight in Oakland...are 41-28 for the season...that is the A's best start since 1992 (41-28).
- Tommy Milone is 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA (15 er in 38.2 ip) over his last six starts...has received three or fewer runs of support in nine of his 14 starts.
- Nate Freiman (1 for 4, 2b) is batting .324 (22 for 68) since May 1 after hitting .148 in April.
- Jed Lowrie (0 for 4) is 4 for 34 (.118) over his last eight games after hitting .412 (21 for 51) over his previous 13 contests.
- Josh Reddick (1 for 3, so, sh) is 13 for 50 (.260) in 13 games since his return from the 15-day disabled list...hit .152 in 29 games before the injury
- Adam Rosales (0 for 4, r) is batting .125 (9 for 72) over his last 27 games after hitting .318 over his first 13 contests.
- Eric Sogard (1 for 3, 2b, rbi, so) is batting .323 (20 for 62) over his last 22 games after hitting .118 over his previous 14 contests.
- Chris Young (3 for 3, r, 2b, hr, rbi, bb) went 3 for 3 with a solo home run after going 4 for 49 (.082) in his previous 14 games.

- Michael Saunders (1 for 4, 2 so) snapped his 0 for 18 hitless streak with a single to right in the ninth inning.
- Mike Zunino (1 for 2, r, hr, rbi, bb, gidp) hit his first career Major League home run, a solo home run in the seventh inning.
