ABOUT SAUNDERS...31-year-old lefty is making his 14th start of the season & 202nd career appearance (all starts) tonight vs. the A's in the series opener at O.co Coliseum.

- Making his final start as a 31-year-old, as he celebrates his 32nd birthday on Sunday (June 16).
- Signed with Seattle as a free agent Feb. 12, 2013.
- Played in college at Virginia Tech, going 27-7 w/Hokies.
- Received special permission from Commissioner Selig to wear a Virginia Tech hat on April 20, 2007 vs. Seattle to honor the victims of the Virginia Tech tragedy.
- Originally selected by Los Angeles Angels as the 12th overall pick of 2002 draft.
- Made ML debut (7.1 IP, 2 ER) in ND 8/16/05 vs. TOR (w/
- LAA)...picked up first MLB win 7/18/06 vs. CLE (7.0 IP, 1 ER).
- Named to AL All-Star Team in 2008.
- **LAST TIME OUT**...on the wrong end of a 3-1 defeat vs. the New York Yankees in his last start June 8 at Safeco Field... dropped to 4-6 with the loss, allowing 7 hits and 3 runs (2 while he was in the game) in 6.1 innings...recorded his 3rd consecutive quality start.
- **STRING THEM TOGETHER**...over his last 3 starts is 1-1 with a 2.29 ERA (5 ER, 19.2 IP) while limiting opposing hitters to a .219 batting average (16x73)... allowed only 1 HR during this stretch...follows a 2-start stretch where he went 0-1, 8.71 ERA May 18 (@CLE) and May 24 (vs. TEX).
- **FAMILIAR FOES**...facing the A's for the 23rd time in his career (all starts), most games he has pitched vs. an opponent in his career (SEA is 2nd-most w/15)...is 14-6, 3.47 ERA vs. the A's, with 14 quality starts...also making his 10th career start at O.co Coliseum (6-3, 3.14), which will mark the most starts he has made as an opponent at a stadium (Safeco Field is 2nd w/9).
- GOING THE DISTANCE...tossed the first of three Mariners complete games this season April 29 vs. Baltimore (Harang has 2 CG)...allowed 4 hits and 2 runs in 9.0 innings to record his 8th career CG (last: 4/27/12 at MIA w/ARI).
- SAFECO JOE...owns a 10-2 record with a 2.31 ERA in 16 career starts at Safeco Field (26 ER, 101.1 IP, 7 HR allowed, 54 K, .224 OPP Avg)...amongst pitchers with at least 10 career starts at Safeco Field, is 2nd behind Bartolo Colon for the highest winning percentage (10-1/.909), and has the 5th-lowest ERA (lwakuma ranks 1st w/1.88 ERA)...in 9 starts as an opposing pitcher went 6-0, 2.13 ERA at Safeco Field</u>...Saunders is 4-2 with a 2.53 ERA in 7 starts at Safeco this season (46.1 IP).
- KEEP HIM IN THE WHITES... is 4-2, 2.53 in 7 starts at home this season, but still looking for his first road victory of the season at 0-4, 9.00 in 6 road starts... has made it out of 6th inning on the road just once: 6 GS, 31.0 IP, 51 H, 31 ER... among qualifying AL pitchers, ranks 8th in home ERA (2.53), and ranks last with a 9.00 ERA.

NOT HIS CAREER NORM...while Saunders has been dominating at home, and had a rough go on the road this season, this is something new for his career...the left-hander entered this season with a 41-31, 3.57 mark on the road (89 GS) and a 37-34, 4.63 record at home (98 GS).

- <u>CAREER</u>...pitching in his 9th Major League season...prior to signing with the Mariners pitched with the Angels (2005-2010), Diamondbacks (2010-2012) and Orioles (2012)...has a combined Major League record of 82-71 with a 4.21 ERA in 202 career starts...since 2008 ranks 6th the Majors amongst *left-handed starting pitchers* in wins (67), ranks 6th in innings pitched (1051.1) and is tied for 5th in games started (169),...averaged 13 wins, 31 starts and 195.0 innings per season (63-57, 156 GS, 974.0 IP) over a five-season stretch from 2008-2012.
- TEAM SAUNDO...Team Saundo was founded in 2007 by Joe Saunders, and his wife, Shanel Saunders...Team Saundo is committed to enhancing the lives of children through various community involvements and initiatives focusing on children's health and well-being, education, and involvement in sports...Team Saundo has purchased a suite for 7 Mariners games this season, and are inviting patients and families from Children's, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, Mary Bridge Children's Hospital and Seattle's Ronald McDonald House to enjoy a day at the ballpark on them.

27-year-old right-hander is scheduled make his 15th start of the season tomorrow vs. the A's at O.co Coliseum...ranks 3rd in the AL with a 2.49 ERA, 2nd in innings pitched (97.2), T3rd in quality starts (10) and 3rd in strikeouts (102)...ND in his last start 6/9 vs. NYY, allowing 5 hits and 1 run in 7.0 IP; 24th career game to allow 1 or fewer runs in 7.0 or more IP and not record a victory (L or ND)...recorded W#7 6/4 vs. CWS (7.1,6,4,4,1,8,HR)...over last 3 starts is 2-0 with a 2.42 ERA (6 ER, 22.1 IP) w/21 K's...W#2 **(#100 of his career)** 4/22 at HOU w/6.0 IP of ShO ball (5 H, 9 SO)...W#1 on Opening Night at OAK, tossing 7.2 shutout innings in a 2-0 SEA win (7.2,3,0,0,1,8)...**CAREER:** Is 105-80 with a 3.17 ERA in 252 career starts...105 career wins is 3rd on the Mariners all-time list, tops among RHP...ranks 1st in franchise history in ERA (min. 30 GS)...since 2009, is 66-44, 2.78 (325 ER, 1051.2 IP) ERA w/996 SO in 148 starts...has 51 career starts 8.0 or more IP and 1 or fewer runs allowed...tossed the 23rd **PERFECT GAME** in MLB history on Aug. 15 vs. TB (9.0,0,0,0,0,12)...**vs. OAK:** Making his 28th career start vs. the A's, second this season (Opening Day)...is 14-6, 2.70 ERA all-time vs. the A's, and 7-2, 2.96 ERA in 14 career starts (3 CG) at O.co Coliseum...3-0, 2.33 ERA (10 ER, 38.2 IP) over his last 5 starts in Oakland.
