OAKLAND NOTES

- Have lost four of their last seven games...are 3-2 on this six-game homestand against New York (3-0) and Seattle (0-2).
- A.J. Griffin is 0-3 with a 4.15 ERA (12 er in 26.0 ip) over his last four starts...the losing streak is the longest of his career.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4, so) is batting .357 (30 for 84) over his last 22 games.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 4, 2 so) is 1 for 21 over his last five games and is batting .121 (4 for 33) in seven games since his batting average peaked at .332 on June 5.
- **John Jaso** (0 for 2, bb) had his career-high nine game hitting streak snapped.
- Seth Smith (0 for 2, so) is 4 for 28 (.143) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in nine games in June...hit .321 in April and .253 in May.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners have won four of their last six games, nine of their last 16, and 11 of their last 20...are 2-0 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (2-0) and Los Angeles (0-0)
- Felix Hernandez is 3-0 with a 1.84 ERA (6 er in 29.1 ip) over his past four starts and has tossed at least 7.0 innings in each of those games.
- Henry Blanco (1 for 4, r, hr, 4 rbi) hit his second career grand slam, his first since May 12, 2000 for Milwaukee at Pittsburgh...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, the gap of 13 years and 34 days between grand slams is the fifth-longest in Major League history.
- Endy Chavez (1 for 5, 2 so) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games and is batting .317 (13 for 41) over that stretch.
- Nick Franklin (1 for 5, 2b) is batting .437 (7 for 16) with three doubles over his last four games.
- Michael Morse (3 for 4, r, 2 2b) had a season-high tying three hits (also: May 14 at New York)...is batting .382 (13 for 34) against Oakland this season.
