TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 2-game series vs Debbie Gallas' Athletics and Game 5 (1-3) of an 8-game road trip that included a 2-1 series loss at Ari and features tomorrow's off day followed by an interleague series at Tex (3g)...following this road trip the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for their final homestand of the season's first half (4g vs SF, 3g vs Sea).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are 4-9 during the regular season vs the Athletics, including 3-0 in 2010 at Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum, 1-2 in 2007 at McAfee Coliseum, 0-3 in 2004 at Network Associates Coliseum and 0-3 in 2002 in the final season of Cinergy Field...during that 2004 series here, the Reds allowed 51 hits and 40 runs in 13-2, 10-6 and 17-8 losses...the Athletics' 40 runs scored were a club record for a 3-game series and the most allowed by Reds pitching in a 3-game series since the Boston Braves scored 40 runs in 12-6, 13-1 and 15-11 wins from 5/4-5/6, 1950 at Crosley Field...the teams split their 2 World Series meetings...Oak won in 7 games in 1972, and Cin Capped its 1990 Wire-to-Wire season with a 4-game sweep in 1990.

<u>UP NEXT:</u> This weekend the Reds will make their second trip to **The Ballpark In Arlington**, their first visit there since 2002... are 5-4 all-time vs the Rangers, including 1-2 at Great American Ball Park in 2007, 3-0 at GABP in 2004 and 1-2 at The Ballpark In Arlington in 2002.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Brandon Phillips leads the Major League with 24 go-ahead RBI and 13 game-winning RBI...bench coach Chris Speier (#35) is coaching third base while Mark Berry recovers from treatment for throat cancer...Miguel Cairo is the club's interim bench coach...Phillips (32nd) and Speier (63rd) will celebrate birthdays Friday.

FAMILY MATTERS: Brandon Phillips is missing this series while tending to a family matter but is expected to rejoin the team Fri in Tex...his spot on the roster has been filled by IF Henry Rodriguez, who prior to last night's game was recalled from Class AAA Louisville...is Rodriguez' second stint with the Reds this season...he was on the roster from 6/7-6/10 and pinch hit on 6/7 vs StL (0-1) and 6/8 vs StL (0-1, 1k)...overall Rodriguez made 68 apps for the Bats (.264, 12 2b, 3hr, 29rbi, 2sb, 33g at 2B, 33g at 3B).

PACING: Jay Bruce is on pace to produce 50 doubles, 37hr and 114rbi...only 17 players in Major League history produced seasons of at least 50 doubles, 35 HR and 100 RBI, including the Reds' Frank Robinson in 1962 (51 2b, 39hr, 136rbi)...Bruce currently ranks 15th in the All-Star balloting among National League outfielders.

IN THE STANDINGS: At 43-29 and 44-29 the Reds were a season-high 15g over .500...enter today's games facing a 3.5game deficit...Cin's largest deficit of the season was 4.0g (6/7, 6/9)...since they led the division on 4/22 the Reds have spent the last 64 days in second, third or fourth place...with the 3 of the 5 best records in the Major Leagues, the Cardinals are on pace to win 100 games, the Pirates 98 and the Reds 93.

ROAD TRIPPIN'....: The Reds won 5 of their 12 road series (1-2 at StL, 0-3 at Pit, 1-3 at Wsh, 1-2 at StL, 3-0 at Cubs, 3-0 at Mia, 1-2 at Phi, 3-0 at NYM, 0-2 at Cle, 2-1 at Pit, 3-1 at Cubs, 1-2 at Ari)...lost their first 4 road series but won 5 of their last 8 road series...after a 1-8 start have improved to 19-19 on the road...have won 18 of 29 road games since a season-high 8-game road losing streak from 4/9-4/27...was their longest road losing streak since an 8-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/26, 2009.

HOME COOKIN'....: The Redlegs are 26-14 at Great American Ball Park, including 13 wins in their last 21g there...their 26 home wins tie the Tigers for the most in the Major Leagues...is their best start after 40 home games since the 1994 club went 29-11 at Riverfront Stadium...won 9 of their 13 home series (2-1 vs LAA, 2-1 vs Wsh, 3-0 vs Phi, 3-1 vs Mia, 2-1 vs Cubs, 1-2 vs Atl, 3-0 vs Mil, 2-1 vs ChiN, 2-0 vs Cle, 1-2 vs Col, 1-2 vs StL, 2-1 vs Mil, 2-2 vs Pit)...won their first 5 home series of the season for the first time since the 1967 club won its first 7 series at Crosley Field.

PIZZA. PIZZA!: Reds pitchers have produced at least 10 strikeouts 27 times this season, including 19 times at Great American Ball Park, and at least 15 strikeouts 4 times (17k on Opening Day vs LAA, 16k on 4/22 vs Chi, 15k on 5/6 vs Atl, 17k on 6/18 vs Pit)...the 17 strikeouts in 13 innings on 4/1 vs LAA was an Opening Day record, while the 17 strikeouts on 6/18 vs Pit tied the club's 9-inning record...Reds pitchers have recorded at least 11 strikeouts at home 12 times.

**CLIMBING**: **Dusty Baker** ranks fourth on the Reds' all-time managerial wins list with **464** (Jack Hendricks 3rd with **469**) and ranks **16th** in Major League Baseball history with **1,626** (Jim Leyland 15th with **1,718**)...9 of the 15 managers ahead of him are in the Hall of Fame...Tony La Russa, Bobby Cox and Joe Torre are not in Cooperstown but rank third, fourth and fifth, respectively, on the all-time wins list...Baker's 20-year career includes **5 division championships** with the Giants (1997, 2000), Cubs (2003) and Reds (2010, 2012)...he is 1 of only 6 managers in **Major League Manager of the Year** 3 times by the Baseball Writers' Association of America (1993, 1997, 2000), twice by *The Sporting News* (1997, 2000) and once by The Associated Press (1993).

### **REDS PITCHERS**

Rank fourth in the National League in ERA (3.50)...on this road trip are 1-3, 6.55 (33ip, 24er)...twice this season recorded 17 strikeouts, in 13 innings on Opening Day vs LAA (Opening Day record) and on 6/18 vs Pit (tying the club record for a 9-inning game).

Rank second in the National League in ERA (3.33, StL 3.03)...on the road trip are 1-2, 6.38 (24ip, 17er) and once was victimized by a blown save.

### RELIEVERS

52 TONY CINCDANI, Ibr

Rank 11th in the National League in ERA (3.88)...on the road trip are 0-1, 7.00 (9ip, 7er) and converted 1-2 save opps...in Tue's 7-3 loss at Oak threw 4.0 hitless innings (Partch 2ip, Parra 1ip, Hoover 1ip)...in the 14-inning, 6-5 loss on 6/13 at Cubs threw a season-high 7.2 innings (7h, 2er, 4bb, 7k).

### 54 AROLDIS CHAPMAN, Ihp Road Trip: 2g, 1sv, 1bs, 0-1, 1ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb

In his career LH batters are 18-for-168 (.107, 3 2b, 1hr, 4rbi, 19bb, 94k)...in his career has allowed only 9 homers, including just 1hr to a LH batter (Luke Scott) and one 2-homer game (5/19/13 at Phi, Kratz & Galvis walkoff)...converted his first 8 save chances before suffering blown saves in consecutive apps on 5/16 at Mia and 5/19 at Phi...then from 5/20-6/19 recorded 10 consecutive saves over 13 scoreless apps (13ip, 4h, 5bb, 26k) until Sat's blown save and 4-3 loss at Ari...struck out the side 5 times...for the first time all season has made 2 consecutive apps without recording a strikeout.
