TONIGHT'S GAME: The Cardinals continue an 8-game (1-1 at HOU, OAK-3, LAA-3), 10-day interleague roadtrip tonight with the first of three games here in Oakland...first pitch is set for 9:05 p.m. CT...the Cardinals snapped a season-high 3 game losing streak on Tuesday, but have lost 4 of their last 5 and are 13-12 in the month of June.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history... in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY: In 2003, the Cards batter the Royals, 13-9, as Jim Edmonds has 4 extra base hits, including 2 HR's...rookie Bo Hart has 4 hits and scores 4 runs for his 7th multi-hit game in 9 outings, raising his BA to .489.

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals snapped their season-high 3-game losing streak with a 13-5 win on Tue. at HOU, but lost 4-3 to the Astros on Wed. to drop into a 1st place tie with PIT in the NL Central...they had held sole possession of 1st place since April 30 and had a season-best 4.0 game lead as recently as June 9...the Cards had an open date yesterday...St. Louis is tied with the Pirates with a Major League best 48-30 record and they lead the majors with a +113 run differential.

INTERLEAGUE: The Cardinals began a string of 11-straight interleague games last Friday (TEX-3, at HOU-2, at OAK-3, at LAA-3) playing their 2nd ever regular season series with Texas...St. Louis is 4-5 (3-1 on road) in interleague play this season, and the Cardinals are 129-115 (.529) all-time in interleague play, the top winning pct. amongst all NL teams...**RARE BIRD SIGHTINGS:** The Cardinals this weekend are making only their 2nd appearance in Oakland, having last appeared at the Coliseum in 2007 when they won 2-of-3 games...the Redbirds will make their first ever visit to Anaheim next week when they will take on the Angels in a 3-game series, completing the circuit of current MLB cities that they had never visited...the Texas Rangers last weekend became the last team to have visited St. Louis prior to this season, although they did get to the Mound City for the 2011 Fall Classic.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Cardinals designated hitters are the all-time leaders amongst N.L. teams in batting (.318; 151-475), on-base pct. (.394) & slugging pct. (.537)...St. Louis has employed Matt Holliday (twice) and Carlos Beltran (twice) as its designated hitters this season...they are batting a combined .286 (4-14) with 1 HR & 1 RBI as DH's.

NO SWEAT: Edward Mujica last Wed. converted his 21st straight save opportunity to begin the season...it's the best start to a season for a Redbirds closer since 1995 when Tom Henke was perfect in his first 22 save opps, the club record..."Chief" Mujica has posted 13 saves without allowing a baserunner this season...Lee Smith had 22 "perfect" saves for the Redbirds in 1992 among his league-leading 43 rescues.

CENTERPIECE: Jon Jay owns the NL's longest active errorless streak (221 games/519 chances) for centerfielders dating back to his last error on Aug. 24, 2011...his 221-game errorless streak is 2nd only to Curt Flood (226 games, 9/3/65 to 6/2/67) amongst Cardinals outfielders.

THREE'S COMPANY & FOUR WAS 1954: For the first time since 1954, the Cardinals have a trio of batters (Molina, Carpenter, Craig) with 94 or more hits through the team's first 78 games...In 1954, four Cardinals (Schoendienst-116, Moon-106, Jablonksi-105 & Musial-104) had 100+ hits in the team's first 78 contests...Molina is currently leading the N.L. in batting (.357), the 17th best start in franchise history thru 78 games.

- ⇒ Suffered 4-2 loss to TEX last Fri. (6/22), as he was touched for a pair of 2-run homers in his 5.2 IP.
- ⇒ Earned his 8th win on 6/17 vs. Chicago Cubs. Came out after 5.0 IP with leg cramping. Allowed no runs over 5.0 IP, 2H, 2BB with 5K.
- ⇒ Ranks 7th in the National League in ERA at 2.35.
- ⇒ Ranks T7th in NL in wins (8), 12th in opp. BA (.212), T5th in WHIP (1.00) and 8th in K's (101), 3rd in K's per 9 IP (9.88).
- ⇒ Is averaging 9.29 base runners per/9 IP, ranking 7th in NL.
- ⇒ Has made seven quality starts. Through the minors & majors, has recorded quality starts (30) all but one start he has thrown 6.0 IP or more (6/12 at NYM).
