- The Oakland Athletics are 14-18 (.438) during the day compared to 33-17 (.660) at night...are 8-3 in interleague play (3-1 vs. San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Milwaukee, 2-0 vs. Cincinnati, 1-1 vs. St. Louis).
- Jarrod Parker** left the game in the fourth inning with right hamstring tightness.
Coco Crisp (0 for 3, bb, gidp) is 4 for 31 (.129) over his last eight games after batting .361 over his previous 16 contests.
- Josh Donaldson** (1 for 3, r, 2b, gidp) is 15 for 42 (.357) over his last 12 games after going 1 for 21 in his previous five contests.
- Jed Lowrie** (1 for 3, so) is 14 for 31 (.452) with seven runs scored and six RBI over his last eight games after going 7 for 47 (.149) with one RBI over his previous 12 games.
- Derek Norris** (2 for 3) recorded two hits after going 4 for 39 (.103) over his previous 13 games.
- Josh Reddick** (1 for 3, rbi) is on a season-high eight-game hitting streak (9 for 28, .321), which has lifted his batting average to a season high .220.
- Eric Sogard** (0 for 3, so) is batting .188 (12 for 64) during the day compared to .310 (35 for 113) at night.

- Allen Craig** (2 for 4, r, 2b, 2 so) is batting .378 (14 for 37) with two doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI over his last 10 games.
- Matt Holliday** (1 for 4, r, rbi) is batting .205 (18 for 88) during the day compared to .301 (59 for 196) at night.
