OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics finished the month of June with a record of 16-11, which marks the A's seventh consecutive month with a winning record dating back to last June...the overall record of 48-35 gives the A's their best record after 83 games since 1992 (48-35).

• Tommy Milone allowed a career-high tying three home runs...has allowed at least one home run in each of his last eight starts...is 1-2 with a 5.96 ERA (15 er in 22.2 ip) over his last four starts.

• Grant Balfour is a perfect 19 for 19 in save opportunities and is one of two Major League closers without a blown save (Mujica, STL).

Coco Crisp (0 for 2, gidp) left the game in the top of the fourth inning with back spasms.

• Jed Lowrie (2 for 4, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) extended his hitting streak to a career-high tying nine games...is 16 for 35 (.457) with nine runs scored and nine RBI over that span after going 7 for 47 (.149) with one RBI over his previous 12 games.

- The St. Louis Cardinals have lost six of their last eight games...are now 2-3 on this eight-game road trip to Houston (1-1), Oakland (1-2), and Los Angeles (0-0).
- Jake Westbrook had his two-game winning streak snapped...is 2-2 with a 5.32 ERA (13 er in 22.0 ip) over his last four starts.
- Matt Carpenter (3 for 5, 2 r, 2 2b, hr, rbi) recorded a career-high three extra-base hits...has hit safely in each of his last 11 games and is 17 for 44 (.386) over that span...extended his interleague hitting streak to 15 games, which is the longest active interleague hitting streak in the Major Leagues.

• Allen Craig (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, bb) is batting .375 (15 for 40) with two doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI over his last 11 games.
