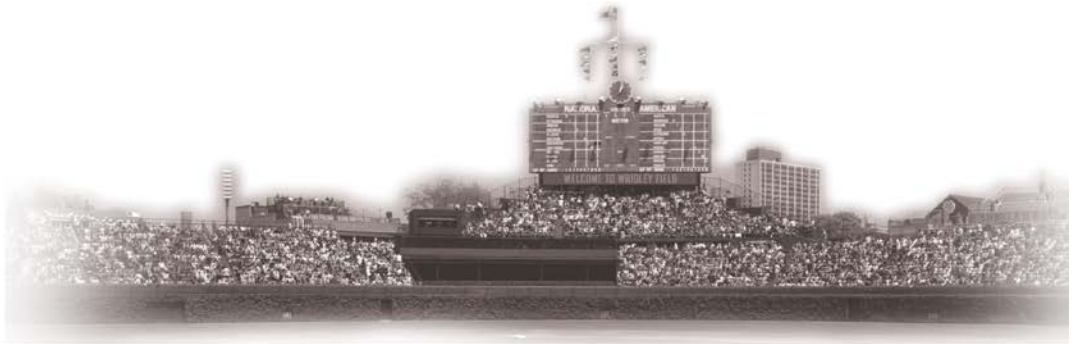

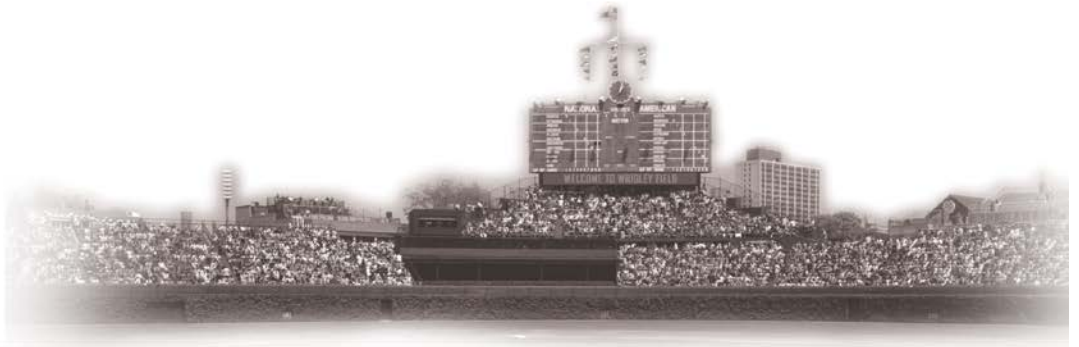
HOMERS – None
