OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics are 5-2 on this eight-game homestand against Cincinnati (2-0), St. Louis (2-1), and Chicago (1-1).

• Bartolo Colon had his eight-game winning streak snapped...it was his first loss since May 14 at Texas...threw his first wild pitch since May 26, 2009 (443.0 ip)...has posted a 1.50 ERA (11 er in 66.0 ip) over last nine starts...became the 242nd pitcher in Major League history to pitch more than 2,500 career innings (2506.2).

• Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 3, bb) is 9 for 55 (.164) with 21 strikeouts over his last 14 games...hit .228 in April, .220 in May, and .232 in June.

• Brandon Moss (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi) has gone 18 for 69 (.261) with six home runs and 12 RBI over his last 18 games.

• Josh Reddick (0 for 3, bb, so) extended his career-high on-base streak to 13 games.

• John Jaso (0 for 3, bb, sb) started for the first time since June 20 at Texas (left palm contusion)...had not appeared in a game since June 23 at Seattle.
