#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have lost two straight games for the first time since June 22 and 23 (at SEA)...have scored six total runs over their past four games (2-2).
- Jarrod Parker** remains unbeaten in his last nine starts (4-0)...has posted a 2.28 ERA (15 er in 59.1 ip) over stretch...is 5-1 with a 2.49 ERA (22 er in 79.2 ip) and .176 opponents batting average (48 for 272) over his last 12 starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (0 for 2, bb, so, hbp) is 6 for 36 (.167) in July...hit .228 in April, .220 in May, and .232 in June.
- John Jaso** (1 for 3, rbi, bb, so) is batting .317 (20 for 63) since June 1.
- Jed Lowrie** (1 for 4, hr, rbi, 2 so) is hitting .347 (25 for 72) over his last 19 games.

- The Boston Red Sox are 5-3 thus far on their current 10-game, 11-day trip to Anaheim (1-2), Seattle (3-1) and Oakland (1-0)...tonight's win sets a Red Sox pre-All-Star break record with 58 wins.
- John Lackey** allowed 3 er or fewer for the 14<sup>th</sup> time in 16 starts this season...was his 12<sup>th</sup> quality start of the season...has posted a 2.32 ERA in 11 outings since May 19 (19 er, 73.2 ip)...10 of last 11 outings have been quality starts.
- Brock Holt** (1 for 3, 2 rbi) extended his hitting streak to six games...started his seventh straight game at third base since being recalled on July 6.
- Dustin Pedroia** (2 for 4, 2 rbi) has reached base in 17 of his last 18 games...hitting .370 (27 for 73, 4 2b, 2 hr, 14 rbi, 9 bb) over stretch.
