OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost three of their last four games against Los Angeles after winning five of their first six...are 3-4 since the All-Star Break...are 0-1 on this ten-game homestand against Los Angeles (0-1), Toronto (three games), and Texas (three games).
- Dan Straily is on a two-game losing streak after having his career-high five-game winning streak snapped last Saturday...is 2-4 with a 6.32 ERA (33 er in 47.0 ip) in nine starts against American League West competition compared to 4-0 with a 2.44 ERA (12 er in 44.1 ip) in seven starts against all other teams.
- Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 2, r, 2 bb, so, sb) has four steals in his last ten games after going 35 consecutive games without a steal.
- Coco Crisp (0 for 4, 2 so) is 20 for 111 (.180) over his last 28 games after batting .361 over his previous 16 contests.
- Jed Lowrie (1 for 4) is 4 for 36 (.111) over his last nine games and is batting .178 (13 for 73) in July, which has dropped his average to a season low .283.
- Josh Reddick (0 for 4) is 4 for 29 (.138) with 10 strikeouts over his last eight games.
