OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics improved to 4-4 since the All-Star Break...are 1-1 on this ten-game homestand against Los Angeles (1-1), Toronto (three games), and Texas (three games)...are now 7-4 against the Angels this season.
- Bartolo Colon tossed six or more innings and allowed three or fewer runs for the 14th straight time...ties the longest streak by an Athletics pitcher since at least 1916 (Dan Haren, April 18-July 26, 2007)...allowed just his third home run since May 20 in the first inning (Trout).
- Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 4, 2 so) is now 2 for 12 (.167) with two walks in four games since the All-Star break.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4, r, sb) recorded an outfield assist in the third inning, his first since Sept. 12, 2012 at Los Angeles (AL)...his stolen base in the second inning was his 30th career stolen base against the Angels, his most against any team.
- Jed Lowrie (3 for 4, hr, 3 rbi, r) recorded three RBI, his fifth game of three or more RBI this season...the five games of three or more RBI rank second on the team (Moss, 6)...had been 4 for 36 (.111) over his previous nine games.
- Seth Smith (0 for 4) has gone 0 for his last 26, the longest hitless streak of his career...previous long streak was 23 at bats without a hit (July 30-Aug. 17, 2010).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are now 4-4 since the All-Star Break and are 1-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Texas (three games).
- **Jerome Williams** allowed four runs or more in five or fewer innings for the fifth straight outing...marks the longest such streak in Angels history...has not won since June 12 at Baltimore...is 0-5 with an 8.37 ERA over his last eight starts (31 er in 33.1 ip).
- J.B. Shuck (2 for 5, r) extended his hitting streak to a career-high eight games with an infield single in the first inning.
- Mike Trout (3 for 5, so, hr, 2 rbi, r) notched his AL-leading 40th multi-hit game of the season.
- Tommy Field (1 for 3, bb, so) recorded his first hit since Sept. 28, 2011 with a single in the second inning.
