### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics improved to 5-4 since the All-Star Break...are 2-1 on this ten-game homestand against Los Angeles (2-1), Toronto (three games), and Texas (three games)...are now 8-4 against the Angels this season.
- Tommy Milone allowed a season-low tying four hits, his third time in a start in which he tossed seven or more innings...is 3-3 with a 4.63 ERA (24 er in 46.2 ip) over his last eight starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 3, bb, 2 so) is now 2 for 15 (.133) with three walks in five games since the All-Star break.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 3, bb, 2 so) is 8 for 49 (.163) over his last 14 games, which has dropped his average to .299, his lowest average since also batting .299 on May 13.
- Derek Norris (1 for 1, r, hr, 2 rbi) recorded a go-ahead pinch-hit home run the seventh inning, his first career pinch hit...was 0 for 12 in his career as a pinch hitter.

- The Los Angeles Angels are now 4-5 since the All-Star Break and are 1-2 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-2) and Texas (three games).
- Garrett Richards made his first start since April 30...is 1-2 with a 4.65 ERA (16 er in 31.0 ip) in six starts this season compared to 1-2 with a 4.10 ERA (19 er in 14.2 ip) in 26 relief appearances.
- Scott Downs had his streak of 29 scoreless appearances (18 ip) snapped in the seventh inning.
- Collin Cowgill (1 for 4, 2 so) extended his career-high six game hitting streak with a single in the first inning.
- J.B. Shuck (0 for 4) had is career-high eight game hitting streak snapped.
- Mark Trumbo (0 for 4, 3 so) recorded a season-high tying three strikeouts (seventh time).
