OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four straight and seven of the last nine games to improve to a season-high 20 games over .500...are 4-1 on this 10-game homestand against Los Angeles (3-1), Toronto (1-0), and Texas (three games).
- A.J. Griffin allowed a season-high tying three home runs (three times, last: July 19 at Los Angeles)...is 4-1 with a 4.86 ERA (20 er in 37.0 ip) over his past six starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes (3 for 5, 2 r, 3b, hr, 3 rbi) snapped his career-high 25-game homerless streak with a solo home run in the eighth inning.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 4, r, bb) snapped his 0 for 17 hitless streak with a single in the fifth inning...the hitless streak was tied for the longest of his career (twice, last; April 13-May 14, 2012).
- Josh Reddick (1 for 4, r, 2b, 3 rbi, sf) recorded three RBI...it is the second game in the last in which he has recorded an RBI.
- Seth Smith (2 for 3, 2b, rbi, bb) snapped his career-high 0 for 30 hitless streak with an RBI double in the third inning.
- Eric Sogard (0 for 4, r, so, hbp) had his career-high seven game hitting streak snapped.
