- Toronto's pitching staff has allowed 7-ER or more in five of their last eight contests...The starting staff has now allowed 19-ER over their last 22 innings of work (four game span)...Esmil Rogers lasted just 4.1 IP in last night's start while allowing 6-ER...It was the 6th time over the last 13 games in which the starter has worked less than six innings (6.05 ERA, 50ER/74.1).

Since June 24, the pitching staff ranks 2nd last in the Majors with a **5.09** ERA (153ER/270.1)...Over that same time, the starting staff ranks **last in the Majors** with an ERA of **5.74** (111ER/174.0) while surrendering a Major League high 32-HR...TOR starters have gone less than 6.0 IP in 13 of those 31 starts.

- THE LONG & WINDING ROAD:

 → Tonight, TOR continues a 10-game road trip with the 2nd of a 3-game set at Oakland...Are 0-1 on the trip after dropping last night's series opener, 9-4...Following the series with the A's, fly to Los Angeles for a 4-game set vs. LAA (48-56)...Following the series vs. conclude the trip with a 3-game series at Seattle (50-55).
