OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost each of their last two games...finish July with a winning record for the eighth consecutive month dating back to last June...that is the fourth longest such streak in Oakland history and is the longest since a 10-month streak from June, 2002 to September, 2003... are 4-3 on their current 10-game homestand against Los Angeles (3-1), Toronto (1-2), and Texas (three games).
- Bartolo Colon** has tossed six or more innings and allowed three runs or fewer in each of his last 15 starts, which is the longest such streak by an Athletics pitcher since at least 1916 (previous: Dan Haren, April 18-June 26, 2007).
- Alberto Callaspo** (0 for 2, so) made his A's debut as a pinch hitter in the seventh inning.
- Eric Sogard** (1 for 3, 2 r) is on a career-high nine game hitting streak...is 13 for 34 (.382) with nine runs, four doubles, a home run and six RBI during the streak.

- The Toronto Blue Jays won the series after losing their past four consecutive road series...went 10-16 in July after going 17-9 in June, 13-15 in May, and 10-17 in April...are 2-1 on their current 10-game road trip to Oakland (2-1), Los Angeles (four games) and Seattle (three games).
- R.A. Dickey** tossed six innings for the fourth consecutive start...is 0-3 with a 4.94 ERA (17 er in 31.0 ip) over his last five starts.
- Brett Cecil** recorded his first Major League save.
- Colby Rasmus** (3 for 5, r, 2b, 2 rbi) has reached base safely in 27 of his last 28 games...is hitting .371 (39 for 105) with 12 multiple-hit games during span.
- Jose Reyes** (2 for 4, bb) snapped his 0 for 13 hitless streak with a single in the third inning.
