That **Jose Bautista** is the 1st TOR player since **Carlos Delgado** to hit **25+** HR in **four** straight seasons (**2010-2013**)...Delgado hit **25** or more HR in a club record nine straight seasons from 1996-2004.

FLEXING HIS MUSCLE:

- Edwin Encarnacion leads the club with 29-HR this season, having homered in three of his last five games...Currently ranks 3rd in the Majors (Chris Davis leads with 38)...Encarnacion also ranks 4th in the Majors with 84-RBI (Miguel Cabrera & Chris Davis lead with 99) as he has knocked in a run in **five** of his last **six** games (**10** total). Edwin ranks **T-2**nd in the AL with **4**-HR after the break & is **T-6**th in the
- AL with 6-HR...Only **Miguel Cabrera** (76-HR) has hit more HR than Encarnacion (71-HR) since the start of **2012** among the Majors.
