OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost three consecutive games...had not lost more than two consecutive games since losing five straight, May 6-10 (four-game sweep at Cleveland, one loss at Seattle).
- Tommy Milone allowed a season-high nine hits...tossed fewer than four innings for the second time in his last four starts...is now 6-4 with a 4.81 ERA (44 er in 82.1 ip) over his last 14 starts after going 3-5 with a 3.71 ERA over his first eight starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4, r, bb, 2 so) is 8 for 23 (.348) with two doubles, one triple and one home run over his last five games after going 2 for 15 over his first five games after the All-Star Break.
- Brandon Moss (2 for 4, 2b, 2 rbi) is 12 for 35 (.342) with two strikeouts over his last 10 games.
- Eric Sogard (1 for 5) extended his hitting streak to a career-high 10 games...is 14 for 39 (.359) with nine runs, four doubles, a home run and six RBI during the streak.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have won a season-high tying five consecutive games...are 5-4 over their last nine games and 6-5 over their last 11.
- Alexi Ogando allowed a career-high five walks...is 0-1 with a 4.61 ERA (7 er in 13.2 ip) in three starts since being reinstated from the disabled list...has made 10 of his 13 starts on the road where he is 2-3 with a 3.42 ERA (20 er in 52.2 ip) compared to 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (5 er in 16.1 ip) in three home starts.
- Elvis Andrus (2 for 5, 2 r) has hit safely in 15 straight games and is 19 for 56 (.339) over that span...the hitting streak is currently the longest active hitting streak in the Major Leagues.
- Adrian Beltre (2 for 4, r, rbi) is batting .350 (42 for 120) with four doubles, nine home runs and 20 RBI over his last 30 games.
- A.J. Pierzynski (2 for 4, 3 rbi) recorded season-high tying (third time) three RBI for the second straight game...is batting .375 (9 for 24) with two home runs and seven RBI over his last six games.
