#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their three game losing streak...have not lost more than three consecutive games since losing five straight, May 6-10 (four-game sweep at Cleveland, one loss at Seattle)...are now 5-4 on the current 10-game homestand against Los Angeles (3-1), Toronto (1-2) and Texas (1-1).
- Jarrod Parker remains unbeaten in his last 12 starts, setting a new career high with five straight wins...snapped a string of six straight no decisions, which matched the longest stretch in franchise history since at least 1916...snapped a streak of 11 straight starts allowing five or fewer hits in three or more innings, which also tied the longest such stretch in franchise history since at least 1916.
- Yoenis Céspedes (1 for 4, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) hit his second home run in his last five home games...had previously gone 25 straight home games without hitting a home run (May 19-July 28).
- Brandon Moss (2 for 4, 2b) extended his hitting streak to seven games (10 for 27, .370)...in his last 11 contests, has gone 14 for 39 (.359) with a double, home run, seven RBI, two walks and two strikeouts.
- Eric Sogard (1 for 2, rbi, 2 sh) extended his career-high hitting streak to 11 games...is 15 for 41 (.366) with nine runs, four doubles, a home run and seven RBI during the streak.

### **TEXAS NOTES**

- The Texas Rangers snapped their season-high tying five-game win streak...are 1-1 on their current 10-game road trip to Oakland (1-1), Los Angeles (three games) and Houston (four games).
- Matt Garza allowed three runs in the first inning...marked the first time this season he allowed a run in the first inning...lost for the first time since June 11 vs. Cincinnati (with Chicago)...had gone 6-0 with a 1.59 ERA (9 er in 51 ip) over his last seven starts prior to this afternoon...tossed his first complete game since Sept. 21, 2011 vs. Milwaukee (with Chicago).
- Elvis Andrus (1 for 3, bb, so, sb) has hit safely in 16 straight games and is 20 for 59 (.339) over that span...the hitting streak is currently the longest active hitting streak in the Major Leagues.
- Leonys Martin (1 for 3, r, bb) extended his current hitting streak to six games (9 for 28, 4 r, 2b, hr, 5 rbi).
- Ian Kinsler (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) hit his first home run since July 11 at Baltimore and his first at O.co Coliseum since Sept. 21, 2011 (60 at bats).
