- 1B Jon Singleton went 1x4 with a walk and 2 RBI...he is hitting .316 (12x38) with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 10 RBI and a .469 OBP in his last 12 games since 7/31.
- CF George Springer (1x4) walked and scored a run...he is the only player in professional baseball with more than 30 HR and 30 steals (31 HR, 38 SB)...is the first minor leaguer in Astros history to reach the 30/30 plateau and the first since Oakland's Grant Desme accomplished the feat in 2009.
