OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 3-4 over their last seven games and 4-9 over their last 13...are 0-2 on their current nine-game homestand against Houston (0-2), Cleveland (three games) and Seattle (three games)...have gone 11-13 since the All-Star break after finishing the first half with a 56-39 record.
- Jarrod Parker tossed a career-high 8.1 innings (previous: 8.0 innings, five times)...is 6-0 with a 2.55 ERA (28 er in 91.2 ip) over his last 14 starts (since May 28)...allowed his 18th home run of the season, which is an on-going career-high (previous: 11 in 2012).
- Eric Sogard (2 for 4, 2 2b) hit a career-high two doubles...is batting .328 (22 for 67) with 11 RBI in 20 games since the All-Star Break after hitting .255 with 13 RBI in 76 games before the break.
- Chris Young (0 for 4) is 2 for 17 (.118) with three walks and seven strikeouts over his last eight games.
- Bob Melvin was ejected from the game in the bottom of the eighth inning.

Chris Carter

- The Houston Astros are 2-0 on their current nine-game road trip to Oakland (2-0), Anaheim (three games), and Texas (three games).
- Jarred Cosart is 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (5 er in 39.0 in) over his first six career starts...has allowed 3 er in 27 ip (1.00 ERA) over four starts on the road...has allowed four hits or fewer in three of his six starts.
- Jose Altuve (2 for 5, r) has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games since July 26...is batting .305 (18 for 59) with five doubles over that span.
- Chris Carter (1 for 5, r, hr, rbi, so) has hit three home runs over his last five games after hitting one over his previous 18 contests.
- Jason Castro (1 for 4, 2 so) extended his career-high hitting streak to 12 games...the hitting streak is a new Astros season high (previous: Altuve, 11 games, May 29-June 10)...has gone 17 for 46 (.370) during the streak.
