OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 5-4 over their last nine games and 6-9 over their last 15...are 2-2 on their current nine-game homestand against Houston (1-2), Cleveland (1-0) and Seattle (three games)...have gone 13-13 since the All-Star break after finishing the first half with a 56-39 record.
- A.J. Griffin has allowed 11 walks over his past two starts (10.2 ip) after allowing 12 walks over his previous 10 starts (64.0 ip)...is 2-2 with a
 4.04 ERA (16 er in 35.2 ip) in six games since the All-Star Break after going 8-6 with a 3.68 ERA before the break.
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4, r, hr, 2 rbi) is the second player in Athletics history to hit 20 home runs in each of his first two Major League seasons...Bob Johnson of the Philadelphia A's hit 21 home runs in 1933 and 34 in 1934...has homered five times in his last 16 games after going homerless in a career-high 25 consecutive games.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 2, sac) had his 18-game streak of reaching base safely snapped...was 16 for 66 (.242) with 12 walks and a hit by pitch during that span.
- Josh Reddick (2 for 4, r, so, sb) is 11 for 31 (.355) with nine runs scored, five home runs, nine RBI and five walks over his last eight games.
- Eric Sogard (1 for 3, rbi) is batting .315 (23 for 73) with 12 RBI in 22 games since the All-Star Break after hitting .267 with 32 RBI in 77 games before the break.

- Justin Masterson is 2-2 with a 3.51 ERA (13 er in 33.1 ip) over his last five starts.
- Asdrubal Cabrera (0 for 4, bb, gidp) is 0 for his last 20.
- Yan Gomes (0 for 4, so, gidp) went 0 for 4 for the first time since July 8 vs. Detroit (18 games)...is 28 for 73 (.384) with 11 runs scored, seven doubles, two home runs, and 10 RBI over his last 23 games.
- Jason Kipnis (1 for 3, 2b, 2 bb) is 16 for 49 (.327) with six runs scored, four doubles, and four RBI over his last 13 games.
