**...THE NAME OF HIS LATEST FLAME:** The Indians took 2 out of 3 to come out of Minnesota with a series victory, winning both games in come-from-behind fashion against the Twins...Cleveland trailed Wednesday's contest for 7 innings until the club erased a 3-7 deficit with a 4-run 8th inning rally that was capped with **JASON GIAMBI**'s game-tying 3-run HR...the Tribe finally took their first lead of the game (8-7) on a lead-off HR by **CARLOS SANTANA** in the top of the 10th, only to watch **JOE MAUER** play spoiler with a solo shot of his own in the bottom half of the frame...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY**'s sac fly in the top of the 12th proved to be the decisive tally in the 4-hour, 20-minute affair...the 2 clubs combined to use 15 pitchers...the Indians are 2-1 to begin this 10-day, 9-game road trip against Minnesota (2-1), Oakland (3 games) and Los Angeles-AL (3 games)...club is coming off a 1-6 homestand against the Tigers (0-4) and Angels (1-2).

**THE STANDINGS:** With a Tigers 4-1 over Kansas City yesterday the Indians lost one half-game on the club's idle Thursday, as **Cleveland holds 2nd place in the A.L. Central standings**, 6.5 games behind first-place Detroit (.592, 71-49)...the Tribe's largest deficit this season is 8.0 games...the latest 2012 calendar date for the Indians to have at least a share of first place was June 23...**the Tribe also sits 3.5 games out of an A.L. Wild Card spot**...Cleveland has been in 1st place for 16 days, 2nd place for 83 days, 3rd place for 15 days, 4th place for 12 days and 5th place for 10 days (2nd place for 56 of last 60 days).

**WINS AND LOSSES:** Cleveland is 14-12 coming out of the All-Star break after going 51-44 in the season's first "half" (T7th in A.L.), most wins for the Tribe at the break since posting a 52-36 mark prior to 2007 Mid-Summer Classic...despite losing 7 of their last 10, the Indians have still won 13 of 21, 18 of 30, 20 of 34, 35 of 58 and 60 of their last 106 games since April 20 (.566, 60-46), the 4th-highest winning pct. in the A.L. during that span and 9th-highest in Majors (see below)...Tribe started the season 5-10 from April 2-19...at 65-56 and 9 games above the .500 mark, Cleveland is 4 wins shy of the club's high-water mark for the season (+13G, 62-49 on Aug. 4) and sits 14 losses ahead of club's low-water mark (-5G, 8-13 on April 28)...Indians are 6-8 to begin August after going 11-13 in April, 18-12 in May, 15-13 in June and 15-10 in July...club has gone 40-24 this season following a win; 24-32 following a loss...the Tribe is 24-14 in games decided in the 7th inning-or-later and 8-2 in extra innings...Cleveland has been at or above .500 for 59 straight days; have not been below .500 since June 17 (34-35).

**SERIES STUFF:** With Wednesday's win, Cleveland improved to 8-2 in rubber games this season, winning 4 of the club's last 6 series...the Indians have gone 20-15-5 in 40 series played thus far in 2013 (13-7-1 at home; 7-8-4 on the road)...Cleveland has gone 11-6-1 over the last 18 series played dating back to June 10...the Tribe is 19-21 in series openers, incl. 6-13 on the road.

**SEE SEE RIDERS:** After playing 14 of previous 17 games in Cleveland (10-7 record; 8-6 at home), the Indians are on the front end of a stretch that has them set to play 15 of a possible 18 tilts on the road where the club has gone 27-31, 9th in the A.L. (6-6 in the 2nd "half")...that said, **the Tribe has won 15 of 25 (15-10) road games since June 11**...the Indians are averaging 4.84 runs-per-game on the road - 2nd-most in A.L. (BOS-4.94) and 3rd in Majors (StL-5.21) - however the pitching staff's 4.36 road ERA is 51 points higher than 3.85 home ERA and 5th-highest in the A.L...meanwhile, **Oakland has allowed the fewest total runs and runs-per-game at home this season** (3.8 RPG, 218R/58G)...Cleveland is 4 road wins shy of matching 2012 total (31-50).

**OAKLAND STROKE...:** Cleveland is set to take on Oakland for the 2nd time in 2013 after sweeping a 4-game set from the Athletics May 6-9 at Progressive Field (Oakland had won 8 straight meetings prior to that sweep)...the Tribe outscored the A's 21-8, posting a 2.00 ERA (8 ER/36.0 IP) and a .205 (27-132) avg. against (4-21 w/ RISP)...Cleveland went just 2-8 vs. Oakland last season (2-4 on the road)...the Indians are 98-136 all-time here at the Coliseum and enter this series on a 4-game losing streak...club has one winning season at this ballpark since start of 2003 (2-1 in 2011), going 12-28 overall in the span.

**LATE ONES, CLOSE ONES:** The Indians improved to a Major League-best 8-2 (.800) in extra-innings with Wednesday's victory (Oakland is 7-5 in extras)...with the 9-8 margin of victory, Cleveland also moved to 24-14 (.632) in one-run games this season, the 2nd-best such record in the A.L. behind only Texas (.677, 21-10) and 4th-best in the Majors...Oakland's 21-16 record (.568) in one-run games is 4th-best in the A.L., as the A's have been engaged in 16 one-run affairs at the Coliseum (11-5 record).

**I'LL BE THERE:** The Indians pitching staff has posted a 3.66 ERA (213ER/524.0 IP) over club's last 58 games dating back to June 11, 5th-lowest in the A.L. and 13th in MLB, which includes a **3.12 ERA** (105ER/303.0IP, 3rd-lowest in A.L., 9th in Majors) and just 14 home runs allowed in 33 games since July 8 - the Tribe is 19-14 in that span, as offense has avg.'d 4.0 runs-per-game (133R/33G) w/ .243 avg. and .671 OPS...**rotation is 11-8 w/ a 3.13 ERA (68ER/195.2 IP) and a .225 opponents avg. over those 33 games**, while the bullpen is 8-6 with a 3.10 ERA (37 ER/107.1 IP), going 12-for-16 in save opp's.

**ON THE WESTERN SKYLINE:** The Indians are a MLB-best 17-6 (.739) vs. teams from the A.L. West (10 G remaining vs. A.L. West, incl. next 6)...Tribe has avg.'d nearly 6 runs-per-gm (5.6, outscoring opponents 129-78) w/ .281 team avg. and 39 HR; staff has a 3.13 ERA (72ER/207.0IP) w/ .230 avg. against...4 of the 6 losses have come on the road...the club's highest win total and best winning pct. vs. A.L. West since '94 realignment came in 1999 when Cleveland posted a 29-13 (.690) record vs. that division...the 17 wins are most for Tribe vs. A.L. West since going 19-18 in 2008.

**THIS DAY IN TRIBE HISTORY: 1920:** At the Polo Grounds in New York, Indians shortstop Ray Chapman was struck in the hit with a submarine pitch from the Yankees Carl Mays; Chapman passed away the next day at the age of 29.

# 63 JUSTIN MASTERSON RHP

## (13-8, 3.59)

**TONIGHT'S START:** The 28-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 26th start and appearance of the season tonight to kick off this 3-game weekend series here in Oakland, also the 206th appearance and 147th start of his career...will be pitching on regular 4 days' rest after logging his shortest outing of the season in his last start on Sunday vs. LAA before the Tribe rallied back to end their 6-game slide...Masterson has spun 15 quality starts this season, as Cleveland is now 16-9 on days where he is on the mound...set to face the A's for the second time this season, owning a 2-5 record with a 7.42 ERA in 11 games against the Athletics in his career.

**RANKINGS:** Masterson's 25 starts are tied for most in the Majors...ranks among A.L. leaders in innings (2nd, 168.0), strikeouts (4th, 171), GB-to-FB ratio (1st, 2.47), strikeouts-per-nine innings (6th, 9.2), pitches thrown-per-inning (13th, 15.6) and opponent batting average (5th, .223)...leads all Indians starters in innings (168.0), strikeouts (171) and WHIP (1.20).

**LAST START:** Masterson was bumped after recording just one out in the top of the 5th, signaling his shortest outing of the season in his last start on Sunday vs. Los Angeles-AL (ND, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 5 R-4 ER, 4 BB, 5 SO, 1 HB, 101 pitches/57 strikes)... allowed a pair of runs in each of the game's first 2 innings and left with his team trailing 5-0 in the 5th... Nick Swisher and Mike Aviles connected on a pair of 2-run homers in the bottom of the 6th and the Tribe rallied for 2 more in the 7th to avoid the sweep and snap a 6-game losing streak.

**VS. OAKLAND:** For his career against Oakland, he has gone 2-5 with a 7.42 ERA (36 ER/43.2 IP) in 11 previous appearances, including a 2-5 record with a 9.08 ERA (36 ER/35.2) in 7 career starts...has never won a game at the Oakland Coliseum, going 0-4 with a 9.13 ERA (23 ER/22.2 IP) through 5 games/4 starts, including 0-2 with a 9.28 ERA in 2 starts last season...logged 8.0 scoreless innings of relief against the Athletics as a member of the Boston Red Sox bullpen (2008-09).

**2013 VS. OAKLAND:** Outdueled today's starter A.J. Griffin back on May 8th at Progressive Field in a 4-3 win over the Athletics...Masterson retired 9 of the first 10 batters he faced through 3.0 scoreless frames before getting touched for all 3 runs in the 4th inning; the A's recorded 4 hits in the frame, including RBI singles by Brandon Moss and Daric Barton...the Indians scored a pair of runs in each of the next two innings to steal another come from behind win...the win snapped an 0-3 slide against the Athletics for Masterson, as he went 0-3 with an 11.66 ERA in 3 starts against the A's last season.

**GONE STREAKIN':** Masterson strung together 3 consecutive wins from July 21-August 1 for the first time since winning 3 straight games from May 8-19 earlier this season...the affable righty pitched to a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) during his 3 game tear, while opponents hit just .149 (11-74) during that span.

**ONE LOVE:** Masterson's 1-0 win in his start vs. Texas on July 27 was his 3rd such victory of the season which ties him with Addie Joss (1908), Stan Coveleski (1917), Jim Bagby Jr. (1943), Bob Feller (1946) and Greg Swindell (1988) for the most 1-0 wins in a single season in Indians history...Coveleski is the all-time leader in 1-0 wins for the Tribe, totaling 9 such victories in his career with the Indians...Masterson has now racked up 4 over his 5 seasons with the Tribe.

**WELCOMED BATTLES:** Masterson has enjoyed success opposite his front of the rotation counterparts thus far on the season...has earned consecutive wins against American League All-Stars Yu Darvish and Chris Sale, while also taking down reigning Cy Young Award winners R.A. Dickey and David Price, and 2011 Cy Young winner Felix Hernandez earlier this season.

**MASTERING THE WHITE SOX:** With Masterson's 4th victory of the season against the White Sox in his start on August 1 here at Progressive Field, he became the first pitcher in the Majors to record at least 4 wins against a single opponent this year...additionally, Masterson joins CC Sabathia (4-0 in 2006) and Luis Tiant (4-0 in 1968) as the only pitcher in Indians history to beat the White Sox 4 times in the same season.

**2013 SPLITS:** Opposing right-handers hitting just .190 (46-242), 4th-lowest in the A.L., while lefties are hitting 54 points higher at .244 (91-373)...his .240 SLG% vs. RH batters is lowest in the A.L...since the start of 2008 (MLB debut season), Masterson has registered an A.L.-low .293 SLG% vs. RH batters with the 3rd lowest avg. vs. RH batters, trailing only Colby Lewis (.216) and Jesse Crain (.216)...this season, opponents are batting .272 (37-136) w/ RISP, incl. .242 (16-66) w/RISP & 2 outs...opponents hitting .257 (64-249) w/ runners on base, but just .199 (73-366) with bases empty...opponents' batting .215 (42-195) the first time thru the order and just .226 (95-420) the 2nd time thru the order and beyond.
