OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics fell to 6-10 over their last 16 games...are 2-3 on their current nine-game homestand against Houston (1-2), Cleveland (1-1) and Seattle (three games)...have gone 13-14 since the All-Star break after finishing the first half with a 56-39 record.
- Dan Straily walked a season-high tying four batters (three times: last, May 15 vs. Texas)...also tossed a season-high 103 pitches (previous: 102, April 5 at Houston)...has gone 0-5 with a 4.09 ERA (15 er in 33.0 ip) since being recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on July 20.
- Alberto Callaspo (0 for 3, 2 bb, so) has gone 1 for 14 (.071) during the current homestand after going 7 for 14 (.500) during the A's most recent six-game road trip...has gone 1 for 24 (.042) at home since joining the A's on July 31.
- Jed Lowrie (0 for 4) has gone 3 for 31 (.097) over his last eight games.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians are 3-2 on their nine-game road trip to Minnesota (2-1), Oakland (1-1), and Los Angeles (three games)...scored a run in the first inning for the first time since Aug. 3 at Miami...scored multiple runs in the first inning for the first time since July 24 at Seattle.
- **Ubaldo Jimenez** allowed three or fewer runs for the 14th time in his last 15 starts...tied a season high with five walks (three times: last, July 4 at Kansas City)....pitched fewer than six innings for the 16th time in 24 starts this season.
- Michael Bourn (2 for 5, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) homered for the third time in his last 22 games (since July 24) after not hitting a home run in his first 62 games after coming off the disabled list on May 10.
- Asdrubal Cabrera (2 for 4, 2b, 2 rbi) snapped a 0 for 20 streak with a single in the first inning.
- Drew Stubbs (2 for 3, 2b, bb, cs) was caught stealing for the first time this season in the second inning...he had been 13 for 13 in stolen base attempts...had the third most stolen bases without being caught in the Major Leagues this season (14: A. Escobar/E. Johnson, Kansas City).
