OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 7-10 over their last 17 games and won their first home series since dropping the previous three...are 3-3 on their current nine-game homestand against Houston (1-2), Cleveland (2-1) and Seattle (three games)...have gone 14-14 since the All-Star break after finishing the first half with a 56-39 record.
- Tommy Milone** is 2-1 with a 1.63 ERA (6 er in 33.0 ip) in five starts against American League Central teams this year...is 5-4 with a 3.55 ERA (26 er in 66.0 ip) in 11 starts at home compared to 4-5 with a 5.00 ERA (40 ER in 72.0 ip) in 12 starts on the road.
- Alberto Callaspo** (3 for 4, 2 r, hr, rbi) hit his first home run as a member of the Athletics in the fifth inning, which snapped a 25-game homerless streak.
- Josh Donaldson** (2 for 5, 3 rbi) now has 42 multiple hit games for the season, which is one more than Josh Reddick's team leading total of 41 from last year...is batting .359 (14 for 39) with eight runs scored and six multiple hit games over his last 11 games...
- Derek Norris** (2 for 4, 2 r, 2b, bb) is batting .346 (18 for 52) with nine walks since July 1...hit .283 in April and combined for a .163 average in May and June.

- The Cleveland Indians are 3-3 on their nine-game road trip to Minnesota (2-1), Oakland (1-2), and Los Angeles (three games).
- Scott Kazmir** was charged with his first loss in a day game this season, is now 4-1 with a 3.46 ERA (15 er in 39.0 ip) in seven starts during the day compared to 3-5 with a 4.84 ERA (43 er in 80.0 ip) in 15 starts at night.
- Asdrubal Cabrera** (2 for 4, 2 so) recorded his second consecutive multiple-hit game after snapping an 0-2 streak in the first inning of yesterday's game.
- Jason Kipnis** (2 for 4, r, rbi, so, sb) is batting .375 (9 for 24) with two doubles and four RBI over his last six games.
