OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 7-4 in their last 11 games after going 1-6 in their previous seven contests...picked up their seventh walk-off win of the season...are 4-3 on their current nine-game homestand against Houston (1-2), Cleveland (2-1) and Seattle (1-0).
- Jarrod Parker** remains unbeaten in in his last 15 starts, the longest streak of his career and the second longest by an A's pitcher in the last 39 years (16, Dan Haren, April 13-July 1, 2007)...it was his first career complete game...has gone 7-0 with a 2.59 ERA (29 er in 100.2 ip) over his last 15 starts...made his fourth error over his last eight starts tonight after making no errors in his first 17 starts.
- Coco Crisp** (0 for 4) started for the first time since August 11 at Toronto (wrist)...pinch ran on August 13 and pinch hit (0 for 1) on August 17...the A's are 56-37 in games that he starts this season...15-16 when he does not start.
- Josh Donaldson** (0 for 3, rbi) has driven in five runs over his last three games after driving in three runs over his previous 26 contests...
- Jed Lowrie** (1 for 4, 2b, so) hit his 33rd double of the season in the fifth inning...he is tied for the most doubles by an Athletic in the last four years (Barton, 2010).
- Brandon Moss** (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi) hit his second walk-off home run of the season and the fourth of his career...it was his sixth career walk-off hit.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 3-4 on their nine-game road trip to Tampa Bay (1-2), Texas (2-1), and Oakland (0-1)...had the leadoff man reach base in five different innings...only one of the five hitters who reached base to start an inning came around to score.
- Aaron Harang** allowed one or fewer runs while pitching at least five innings for the third time in his last six starts...is winless in his last five starts (0-2, three no decisions).
- Kendrys Morales** (2 for 4, rbi) is batting .322 (37 for 115) with three home runs and 12 RBI since the All-Star break...has gone 7 for 27 (.259) on the current road trip...recorded his second multi-hit game in his last 10 contests after recording seven multi-hit games in his previous nine contests.
- Justin Smoak** (1 for 4, so) is batting .301 (44 for 146) with eight home runs and 21 RBI since July 1.
