Tonight is the 15th of 19 games between the Mariners and Athletics this season...the Mariners lead the season series 8-6, and have won 5 of last 8 vs. the A's...are 3-0-1 in series vs. the A's this season...trail the all-time series 232-310, going 100-173 at Oakland Coliseum (4-4 this season)...have not posted a winning record in Oakland since 2009 (6-4).

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 3-team, 9-game road trip tonight with the second of a three-game series vs. the Athletics (0-1)...took 2 of 3 from the Rangers over the weekend and opened the trip losing 2 of 3 at Tampa Bay...have an off day Thursday and open a 6-game homestand vs. the Los Angeles Angels (3 games) and Texas Rangers (3 games) on Friday...the Mariners are 14-15 since the All-Star break and 21-20 since July 1...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports** in high definition & broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle & the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...lost yesterday and have gone 3-4 during current road trip...dropped 14 of last 22 games, and are 9-15 following season-high 8-game winning streak (July 12-23)...29-26 vs. the AL West, 12-17 vs. AL East, 9-14 vs. AL Central and 7-10 in Interleague play...are 31-32 at Safeco Field and 26-35 on the road (12-10 over last 22 road games).

- **K/9.0 IP** - Mariners relievers lead the AL averaging 9.68 K/9.0 IP...**Danny Farquhar** (5th, 13.39), **Oli-ver Perez** (6th, 12.76) and **Charlie Furbush** (10th, 12.42) are among AL leaders.
- **Early & Late Homers** - Mariners have hit 50 HR in 7th inning or later, most in MLB...also hit a MLB-best 24 home runs in the first inning this season (8 leadoff) and 6 home runs in extra innings.
- **Shutouts** - Mariners rank 3rd in the AL with 11 shutouts this season (CLE - 15, TB - 13).
- **Tough Trip** - On this 9-G road trip the Rays/Rangers/A's have a combined record of 214-158 (.575).
- **Opponent CG** - RHP Jarrod Parker tossed the first 9.0-inning complete game vs. the Mariners since Minnesota RH Liam Hendriks on Aug. 27, 2012 at Safeco Field (9.0,3,1,1,3,6,HB).

**VS. THE AL WEST**...the Mariners have a winning record (29-26) vs. the American League West (7-5 vs. HOU, 8-6 vs. OAK, 7-6 vs. LAA, 7-9 vs. TEX)...have not posted a winning record within the division since going 31-26 in 2009...are 4-1-0 in last 4 road series vs. the AL West.

**NO MARGIN FOR ERROR**...58 of the Mariners 124 games this season have been decided by 2 or fewer runs...own a 30-28 record in these games, going 17-21 in 1-run games and 13-7 in 2-run games...each of the Mariners last 6 wins have been by 2 or fewer runs.

**WHAT A START**...RHP **Aaron Harang** allowed only 1 run in 7.0 innings, but recorded a ND in Mariners 1-2 loss vs. the A's last night...marked the 29th time this season a Mariners starting pitcher has tossed at least 7.0 innings and allowed 1 earned run or less, which is T1st in the American League (also: DET) and T3rd in the Majors (CIN -32, LAD - 30)...RHP **Felix Hernandez** leads the AL with 12 such starts.

**THAT ONE HURT**...the Mariners suffered their 10th walk-off defeat last night, tying for the most in American League (BAL - 10, CWS - 10, DET - 10, SEA - 10) and tying for the 3rd-most in the Majors (MIA - 12, NYM - 12)...also the 19th loss in the final at-bat this season, 2nd-most in the AL behind the White Sox (20)...the Mariners have suffered 46 walk-off losses over the last 4 seasons, most in the Majors during that span (STL is 2nd w/36).

**STREAKING AWAY**...**Kendrys Morales** has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games on the road with 8 multi-hit games...since July 21, Morales is batting .421 (24x57) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 home run and 8 RBI...during this 14-game stretch he leads the Majors in average...overall he batting .287 (66x230) with 22 runs scored, 10 doubles, 9 home run and 32 RBI in 58 road games this season.

**LORD FARQUHAR**...new closer **Danny Farquhar** has earned the save in each of the Mariners last 7 wins, the first saves of his Major League career...since becoming the closer on Aug. 3, Farquhar is 7-for-8 in save opportunities...he has retired 34 of his last 41 batters faced (6 H, IBB).

**SMOAKIN'**...**Justin Smoak** has recorded a hit in 15 of his last 18 games, batting .313 (21x67) with 3 doubles, 5 home runs and 11 RBI during this stretch...since coming off the DL on June 18 he has a quad-slash (avg/obp/slg/ops) of .294/.374/.528/.902 with 11 of his 14 home runs...here is a hitting breakdown of Smoak's first 46 and last 49 games this season:

**HOME RUN DERBY**...the Mariners rank 4th in the Majors with 147 home runs (BAL-166, TOR-150, ATL - 149, **SEA-147**)...Seattle is the only team with 8 players with 10+ home runs...also lead the Majors in percent of runs scored via the home run...Seattle has scored 494 runs this season, including 231 via the homer; that's 46.8% of its runs via homers, **tops in the Majors**...the Mariners are just 2 home runs short of matching the season total from last season (149).

**YOUNG UP THE MIDDLE**...**Brad Miller** (SS) and **Nick Franklin** (2B), both rookies, have made **35** starts together this season in the middle infield...marks the T2nd-most starts by a rookie 2B/SS combination in club history, and most since the club's inaugural season in 1977 (Jose Baez-2B, Craig Reynolds-SS; 54 games & Julio Cruz-2B, Craig Reynolds-SS; 35 games)...the **35 combined starts by Miller & Franklin are tied for the most by an AL rookie middle infield combo dating back to 1995: Andy Fox & Derek Jeter (NYY, 35 GS in 1995).**

**AS YOU KNOW?**...LHP **Joe Saunders** is 5-1 with a 2.11 ERA (9 ER, 38.1 IP) in his last 6 starts following a Mariners loss (7-3 overall in 2013)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...**Saunders** is 10-1 with a 2.18 ERA (18 ER, 74.1 IP) vs. the Athletics when following a team loss in in 11 starts career, including going 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (6 ER, 36.2 IP) in starts in 5 such start at Oakland?...**Saunders** is 7-3 with a 2.94 ERA (21 ER, 64.1 IP) in 10 career starts at O.co Coliseum...his 2.94 ERA currently ranks 7th amongst active pitchers at OAK.

**ABOUT SAUNDERS**...32-year-old lefty is making his 26th start of the year & 234th career start tonight vs. the A's.

- Signed with Seattle as a free agent Feb. 12, 2013.
- Played in college at Virginia Tech, going 27-7 w/Hokies.
- Received special permission from Commissioner Selig to wear a Virginia Tech hat on April 20, 2007 vs. Seattle to honor the victims of the Virginia Tech tragedy.
- Pitching in his 9th ML season...also pitched with the Angels (2005-2010), Diamondbacks (2010-2012) and Orioles (2012).
- Originally selected by Los Angeles Angels as the 12th overall pick of 2002 draft.
- Made ML debut (7.1 IP, 2 ER) in ND 8/16/05 vs. TOR (w/ LAA)...picked up first MLB win 7/18/06 vs. CLE (7.0 IP, 1 ER).
- Named to AL All-Star Team in 2008.
- Is 14-20 with a 5.52 ERA (142 ER, 231.2 IP) in 41 career starts in the month of August.
- Has recorded 10+ wins for the 5th consecutive season.

**LAST TIME OUT**...lasted only 4.1 innings for the second consecutive start in his last outing Aug. 15 at Tampa Bay (4.1,7,5,5,3,0,HR)...first time in his career with back-to-back starts where he did not pitch at least 5.0 innings... allowed only 1 run through the first 4.0 innings, but allowed 5 hits and got only one out in the bottom of the 5th inning (2-run HR by Evan Longoria)... is 1-4 with a 7.77 ERA (21 ER, 24.1 IP).

**HE LOVES OAKLAND**...Saunders is 15-6 with a 3.36 ERA (52 ER, 139.1 IP) in 23 career starts vs. the A's...the 15 wins are the most he has recorded vs. an opponent in his career, as are the 23 starts, 139.1 IP and 84 strikeouts... also owns a 7-3 record at O.co Coliseum, the most wins as a visiting pitcher in his career...has recorded a quality start in 7 of 10 outings in Oakland.

**DECISION MAKER**...has recorded a decision (either win or loss) in 14 consecutive starts (June 3-current), going 7-7 with a 4.29 ERA (38 ER, 79.2 IP)...last recorded a no-decision May 29 at San Diego...the 14 consecutive starts without a no-decision is tied for the 2nd-longest by a Mariners pitcher since 2000...**Felix Hernandez** made 15 consecutive starts with a decision April 18-July 3, 2006.

**4 IS THE MAGICAL NUMBER**...went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (15 ER, 35.2 IP) in 6 starts in July...marks the 4th time to record at least 4 wins in a single month in his career: July 2011 (4-1, 2.16 ERA), Sept. 2009 (4-0, 2.78 ERA) and April 2008 (5-0, 2.08 ERA).

**GOING THE DISTANCE**...Saunders tossed the first of four Mariners complete games this season April 29 vs. Baltimore (Harang has 2 CG)...allowed 4 hits and 2 runs in 9.0 innings to record his 8th career CG (last: 4/27/12 at MIA w/ ARI)...added another CG in the aforementioned loss at LAA.

**TOUGH ON LEFTIES**...holding left-handed batters to a .220 (29x132) batting average this season with only 8 extra base hits (2B-7, HR-1)...was holding lefties to a .192 avg (15x78) through first 16 starts, but over last 7 starts opposing LH batters are 14-for-54 (.259)...allowed a home run to Jacoby Ellsbury on July 30 vs. Boston, the first home run allowed vs. a left-handed batter since Sept. 28, 2011 vs. the Dodgers (James Loney).

**SOUTHPAW**...since 2008 has recorded 73 wins (73-69 record), tied for 5th-most wins in the Majors by a left-handed pitcher...Saunders trails CC Sabathia (102-49), Jon Lester (85-53), Cliff Lee (81-48), Mark Buehrle (76-64), and tied with Clayton Kershaw (73-44)...also ranks 7th in innings pitched (1,118.1) and is 5th in games started (181)...averaged 13 wins, 31 starts and 195.0 innings per season (63-57, 156 GS, 974.0 IP) over a five-season stretch from 2008-2012.

**2013 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS...**

- Tossed 2 of the Mariners 4 complete games: W on 4/29 vs. BAL (9.0,4,2,2,1,2,HR), L on 6/19 @LAA (8.0,6,1,1,2,3).
- Thrown more than 100 pitches 11 times this season (8 of last 13 starts), including season-high 120 pitches 5/18 at CLE, which is tied for the second-highest total of his career (also 7/20/11 vs. MIL w/ ARI).
- Won his 10th game Aug. 4 at BAL (3-2)...was his fourth career season with double-digit wins (also: 2008, 2009, 2011).
- Flew out to center field to end game in the 11th on June 29 vs. CHI...is the first Mariners pitcher to get an at-bat in a non-NL city game, since Mike Schooler batted in the 13th inning at Boston on Aug. 11, 1990.

**TEAM SAUNDO**...Team Saundo was founded in 2007 by Joe Saunders, and his wife, Shanel Saunders...Team Saundo is committed to enhancing the lives of children through various community involvements and initiatives focusing on children's health and well-being, education, and involvement in sports...Team Saundo has purchased a suite for 7 Mariners games this season, and are inviting patients and families from Children's, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, Mary Bridge Children's Hospital and Seattle's Ronald McDonald House to enjoy a day at the ballpark on them.

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP HISASHI IWAKUMA (11-6, 2.95)**

32-year-old right-hander will make his 27th start of the season and 43rd career MLB start tomorrow in the series/road trip finale vs. the A's...ranks 8th in the American League with a 2.95 ERA, 5th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.71) and 2nd in WHIP (1.00)...earned his 11th win his last start 8/16 at Texas (7.0,4,1,1,3,8)...tied with Bartolo Colon for the MLB lead with 10 starts without allowing a walk (4th in AL with 1.63 BB/9.0 IP)...W#10 on 7/25 vs. MIN (6.0,4,0,0,1,9)...went 7-1, 1.79 ERA in first 14 starts this season...allowed 12 HR in his last 11 starts (just 1 in last 6 GS)...leads the staff allowing 22 HR this season (T10th-most in AL)...did not allow an **earned run** in 31.2 consecutive innings 5/26-6/16, the 2nd-longest streak in club history...**All-Star** -- Was named to his first MLB All-Star team this year, but did not pitch in the Midsummer Classic (made 3 All-Star teams in Japan)...**Starter** -- Is 19-10, 2.84 ERA (84 ER, 266.0 IP) in 42 career starts (7/2/12-current)...**vs. OAK** -- Is 2-4 with a 4.45 ERA (16 ER, 32.1 IP) in 6 G/5 GS vs. the A's in his career (2-2, 3.96 ERA in 4 GS this season).
