OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won five of the last seven games...are 20-19 since the All-Star Break after going 56-39 before the break.
- Jarrod Parker is 8-0 with a 2.57 ERA (33 er in 115.2 ip) over his last 17 starts...has a 17-game unbeaten streak, which ties Catfish Hunter (June 2-September 3, 1973) for the Oakland record...had his streak of three games in which he tossed at least eight innings snapped...he is just the second pitcher over the last nine years with three consecutive starts of eight of more innings (Cahill, July 28-August 8, 2010).
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4, so) is batting .280 (21 for 75) in 19 games in August.
- Josh Donaldson (2 for 4, 2 2b) is batting .313 (26 for 83) with 15 runs scored, 16 RBI and nine multiple hit games over his last 22 games.
- **Jed Lowrie** (1 for 4, 2b, rbi) is on a career-high 12-game hitting streak, which is the longest active streak in the AL...is 20 for 50 (.400) with 10 runs, nine doubles, two triples, one home run, nine RBI and six multiple hit games during the streak.
- Kurt Suzuki (2 for 3, r, hr, 3 rbi, so) recorded a season-high tying three RBI...is batting .400 (6 for 15) in three games since returning to the Athletics

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Rays have lost five of their last six games...are 11-14 in August, and with tonight's loss have ensured a losing record in the month of August for the first time since 2006 (9-19)...are 0-1 on their 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles (four games), and Seattle (three games).
- David Price had his streak of five consecutive wins snapped, which was tied for the second longest winning streak of his career (longest: eight, June 19-August 16, 2012)...is 7-2 with a 2.12 ERA (21 er in 89.1 ip) since returning from the disabled list on July 2.
- Desmond Jennings (0 for 3, r, bb, so, sb) is batting .114 (4 for 35) with eight walks and six strikeouts since his return from the 15-day disabled list on August 19
- Evan Longoria (1 for 4, gidp) snapped his 0 for 18 hitless streak with a single in the eighth inning.
- Ben Zobrist (2 for 4, 2b, bb) snapped his 81-game errorless streak with a throwing error in the fifth inning...the streak was an ongoing Tampa Bay franchise record.
