#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics lost for just the third time in their last 11 games...the loss snapped a four-game winning streak...are now 4-1 on their current 10-game homestand against Tampa Bay (3-0), Texas (1-1) and Houston (four games).
- Bartolo Colon pitched five or fewer innings for the fourth straight start since going six or more innings in 15 straight starts...allowed more than seven hits for the first time since July 14...opponents are batting .387 (29 for 75) against him over his last four starts.
- Yoenis Céspedes (2 for 4) recorded his third straight two-hit game...has hit safely in six of his last seven contests...is hitting .370 (10 for 27) over span.
- Michael Choice (1 for 3, 2 so) recorded his first Major League hit, an infield single in the fifth inning.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5, r, 2b, 2 so) has scored at least one run in six straight games and 12 of his last 13...has scored 15 total runs during the 13-game stretch ...is batting .346 (18 for 52) with seven home runs over that 13-game span.

### **TEXAS NOTES**

- The Texas Rangers snapped a short two-game losing streak...have not lost three games in a row since dropping four straight against New York (AL) and Cleveland from July 25-28...have gone 24-9 since that four-game losing streak.
- Martin Perez earned his sixth straight win in as many starts...became the first Texas pitcher to win six consecutive starts since Kenny Rogers won eight straight starts in a row from April 27-June 5, 2005...his six-game win streak (including no decisions) is the longest by a Rangers pitcher since Matt Harrison's seven-game streak from May 22-June 29, 2012...his nine wins are tied for the most ever by a Rangers left-handed rookie pitcher (Matt Harrison, 2008).
- Mitch Moreland (2 for 4, r, 2b, hr, rbi, bb, so) hit his fifth home run in 11 games against the A's this season...was his seventh home run in 23 career games at O.co Coliseum...now has 10 home runs against Oakland, the most he has hit against any opponent.
- Alex Rios (2 for 5, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his second home since being acquired by Texas on August 9...was just his second home run in his last 29 games overall (since July 21).
