OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won five of their last six games and nine of their last 12 to move into a tie with Texas for first place in the AL West for the second time in the past two days.
- Jarrod Parker is 9-0 with a 2.59 ERA (35 er in 121.2 ip) over his last 18 starts...the winning streak is an ongoing career high (previous: four, September 10-October 1, 2012), and is a new A's season high (previous: eight, Colón, May 20-June 28)...the last A's pitcher to win more than nine straight is Dan Haren, who won 10 straight from April 18- July 1, 2007...is on a 18-start unbeaten streak, which is the longest in Oakland history (previous: 17, Catfish Hunter, June 2-September 3, 1973).
- Daric Barton (2 for 3, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) is 8 for 25 (.320) with six RBI in nine games since his return.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4, 2 r, hr, 4 rbi,) recorded a season-high four RBI...has hit four home runs over his last five games.
- Brandon Moss (2 for 4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) is 4 for 13 with three home runs against Darvish in his career.
- Stephen Vogt (2 for 4, 2 r, 2 2B) extended his career-high seven game hitting streak (9 for 26, .346)...recorded two doubles for the first time in his career.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers snapped their streak of 31 consecutive games in which they allowed five runs or less, which was the longest such streak in the majors since the Los Angeles Dodgers went 31 games (August 10- September 12, 2009)...it was the longest streak in the AL in the designated hitter era.
- Yu Darvish allowed a season high, career-high tying six walks (fourth time, last: August 1, 2012 vs. Los Angeles)...is 1-5 with a 4.86 ERA (20 er in 37.0 ip) in six career starts against Oakland.
- Craig Gentry (2 for 4, rbi) is 10 for 29 (.345) over his last 11 games and is batting .338 (25 for 74) over his last 35 games since being reinstated from the disabled list.
