### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics are now in sole possession of first place in the AL West by ½ game over Texas after beginning the day in second place by ½ game behind Texas...it is the first time the A's have been in sole possession of first place since August 6.
- A.J. Griffin recorded a career-high tying nine strikeouts...is 8-3 with a 3.92 ERA (38 er in 87.1 ip) in 14 starts since June 20.
- Yoenis Céspedes (2 for 5, r, rbi, so) is 9 for 24 (.375) in September after batting a career-worst .216 in August...has hit safely in 10 straight games against Houston (15 for 41, .365) after going 0 for 11 in his first three games against the Astros.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3, 2r, 3b, 2 bb) has recorded at least one extra-base hit for a career-high seven consecutive games...is the first Athletic to have an extra-base hit in seven consecutive games since Eric Byrnes, May 8-15, 2003.
- Josh Donaldson (3 for 5, 3 r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi, sb) scored a career-high three runs...is batting .349 (22 for 63) with 13 runs, nine RBI and 10 walks in 17 games against Houston.
- Jed Lowrie (2 for 5, r, 2b, 2 rbi, 2 so) recorded his 42<sup>nd</sup> double of the season...his 42 doubles are the most in a season by an Athletics player since Miguel Tejada recorded 42 doubles in 2003.
- Derek Norris (1 for 3, so) made his first start after being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list yesterday and singled in his first at bat in the second inning.

#### **HOUSTON NOTES**

- The Houston Astros are 1-1 on their current seven-game roadtrip to Oakland (1-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Dallas Keuchel tossed only 3.1 innings after going at least 7.0 innings in four of his previous five starts dating back to July 27...is 1-3 with a 5.51 ERA (23 er in 37.1 ip) over his last six starts.
- Brandon Barnes (0 for 2, 2 so) was ejected from the game in the top of sixth inning by home plate umpire Alan Porter...it is the first player ejection for the Astros this season...had his career-high tying six-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .474 (9 for 19) with eight RBI during the streak.
- Trevor Crowe (2 for 5, r, 2b, rbi) extended his hitting streak to eight games, dating back to June 22...has gone 13 for 31 (.419) during the streak
- Jonathan Villar (3 for 5, 2 r, 2b, rbi, 2 so) is batting .412 (7 for 17) over his last six games.
