OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their eighth walk-off win of the season...lowered their magic number to clinch to AL West to six...are 9-2 over their last 11 games and 33-23 since the All-Star Break...are 1-1 on their seven-game homestand against Los Angeles (1-1) and Minnesota (four games)
- Sonny Gray is 2-1 with a 1.26 ERA (5 er in 35.2 ip) in five games at home compared to 1-2 with a 4.91 ERA (10 er in 18.1 ip) in five games on the road.
- Josh Donaldson (3 for 5, rbi, 2 so) recorded his third walk-off hit of the season and of his career...extended his on-base streak to 22 games, the longest streak by an Athletic over the past two years.
- Brandon Moss (2 for 4, 2 2b, rbi, so) hit a season-high tying two doubles (second time, last: September 11 at Minnesota)...is batting .346 (26 for 75) with 18 runs, nine home runs and 24 RBI over his last 26 games.
- Eric Sogard (1 for 2, bb) is 8 for 25 (.320) over his last 10 games after going 11 for 62 (.177) over his previous 19 games.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 6-3 on their current 10-day, four-city road trip to Minnesota (0-1), Toronto (3-0), Houston (2-1) and Oakland (1-1).
- Garrett Richards is 3-0 with a 2.10 ERA (6 er in 25.2 ip) over four starts in September.
- Erick Aybar (2 for 4, so) recorded his 46th multi-hit game of the season, which is tied for second most among Major League shortstops (Segura, 47).
- Howie Kendrick (1 for 4, 3 so, hbp) struck out a season-high three times.
- J.B. Shuck (1 for 4, bb, so, sb) leads AL rookies with 120 hits and 151 total bases...is batting .311 (50 for 161) over his last 31 games.
- Mike Trout (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so, hbp) became the first player in AL history to record 25 home runs, 30 stolen bases, and 100 walks in a season...has recorded at least 25 home runs and 30 stolen bases for the second consecutive season...was the youngest player to ever accomplish the feat in 2012, and is now the second youngest at 22 years and 40 days of age.
