OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics lost their first series since August 23-25 at Baltimore...had won seven straight series...fell to 7-6 in extra-inning games.
- A.J. Griffin tossed at least six innings allowing two hits or fewer for the second straight start and fourth time in his career...has given up just three hits and three runs over his last 15 innings (3 bb, 19 so)...allowed his Major League leading 35th home run of the season.
- Yoenis Céspedes (2 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi, 2 so) set a new career high with his 24th home run...hit 23 homers last year in his rookie season...is batting .365 (23 for 63) with 10 multiple hit games in 17 games in September.
 Coco Crisp (1 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi) extended his ongoing career high with his 20th home run of the season...is the third-highest home run total
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi) extended his ongoing career high with his 20th home run of the season...is the third-highest home run total ever for an Oakland A's leadoff hitter (Henderson, 28, 1990; Campaneris, 22, 1970)...was his 10th homer in his last 26 games after hitting 10 in his first 97 games...is one stolen base short of his first career 20 home run/20 stolen base season.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels remain unbeaten in their last eight series (7-0-1)...improved to 6-65 when trailing after eight innings and 7-8 in extra innings...went 7-3 on their 10-day, four-city road trip to Minnesota (0-1), Toronto (3-0), Houston (2-1) and Oakland (2-1).
- Jason Vargas is 0-2 with a 8.41 ERA in his last four starts (19 er in 20.1 ip)...tied a season high with two home runs allowed...has allowed 52 home runs since the beginning of 2012 (third most in AL)...fell to 5-18 in his career when giving up at least two home runs.
- Josh Hamilton (1 for 4, r, hr, 3 rbi, so, sf) hit his second career game-tying home run in the ninth inning or later (also July 4, 2013 vs. STL).
- Mike Trout (1 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) hit a home run in three consecutive games for the first time in his career.
