LAST START: Was the loser in his last start September 13 vs. Tampa Bay opposite Chris Archer...he allowed three runs on eight hits with one walk and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...threw 96 pitches, 60 earned his team-leading 16th quality start and 89th of his career...Correia has posted an ERA. of 2.87 (47.0 IP. 15 ER) in his last seven starts...Twins were shutout for the 12th time this season. 3-0.

PRIOR START: Was the loser in his start September 7 vs. Toronto opposite J.A. Happ at Target Field...allowed ve runs on seven hits with one walk and four strikeouts, threw 95 pitches, 59 strikes. .all five runs scored came in the first inning...the 11 losses tie his career-high for a single season (also 2012, 2011, 2009).

10-SPOT: He is seeking his 10th win, which would mark his fifth consecutive season with double-digit victories...he won 12 in 2009 and 10 in 2010 with San Diego, he won 12 in both 2011 and 2012 with Pittsburgh.

EATING INNINGS: He has pitched 173.1 innings this season, the second most of his career...his 6.0 innings pitched in his last start, surpassed his 2012 total of 171.0...he needs 24.2 innings pitched to tie his singleseason career-high of 198.0, done in 2009 with San Diego.

FACING THE ATHLETICS: Correia will be making his fourth career start and seventh career appearance against the A's...he was the winner in his previous start June 21, 2009 vs. Oakland as a member of the Padres...he allowed one run on two hits with one walk and seven strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched...he has a career record of 1-1, 3.10 ERA (20.1 IP, 7 ER) with eight walks and 16 strikeouts in six appearances (3 starts) against the A's.

YOU'RE GROUNDED: Correia has forced opponents to ground into 24 double plays this season, a mark that -most in all of baseball and third-most in the American League...the Twins as a team are third most is sixtl in all of baseball and second in the AL with 139 opponent grounded into double plays

TWIN LEADER: He leads all Twins pitchers this season with 99 strikeouts...he also leads the Twins in innings pitched (173.1), game starts (29) and quality starts (16)...he leads the Twins starting rotation with a 2.48 strikeout-to-walk ratio and walks-per-9.0-innings (2.08).

**<u>QUALITY CORREIA:</u>** Tossed his 89th career quality start on September 13 vs. Tampa Bay...tossed five straight quality starts to begin the season...is the first player to start his Twins career with five straight quality starts since Ramon Ortiz in 2007...has a career 45-19, 2.43 ERA (573.2 IP, 155 ER) with 141 walks and 367 strikeouts in those 89 quality starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 113 of his 188 career starts (60%) and at least 7.0 innings in 27 career starts.

KEVIN'S SEVEN-PLUS: In his 29 starts this season, Correia has recorded at least 7.0 innings 10 times... he had just three 7.0-plus outings in all of 2012...he was the first player in history to start his Twins career with five straight outings of at least 7.0 innings...he is the first Twin to start a season with five straight outings of at least 7.0 innings since Carlos Silva in 2005.

THE FAMILIAR AMERICAN LEAGUE: Correia had spent all 10 years of his major league career with National League teams prior to signing as a free agent with the Twins...Correia has made 40 starts and 10 relief appearances against American League clubs in his 11 MLB seasons...in all 50 appearances he has a career record of 13-17, 4.10 ERA (248.1 IP, 113 ER), 63 walks, 134 strikeouts...in his 40 starts he is 13-17, 4.16 ERA (240.0 IP. 111 ER) with 58 walks and 140 strikeouts.
