OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics clinched their second-straight AL West division title...is the 17th postseason appearance in Oakland history and the 25th in Athletics franchise history...is the 16th division title in franchise history...only the Yankees (18) and Braves (17) have more...the A's now trail Boston by 1.5 games for the best record in the AL and lead Detroit by two games for the second-best record.
- The A's outscored Minnesota 39-14 in this four-game series sweep...the 39 runs are tied for the most in a four-game series in Oakland history (August 22-25, 2003 at Toronto)...it was the A's 12th sweep of the season...have been swept just three times.
- Sonny Gray** has allowed 20 of his 22 runs this year in the first three innings of a game...has a 5.66 ERA (17 er in 27.0 ip) in innings one through three and a 0.56 ERA (2 er in 32.0 ip) from the fourth inning on...improved to 3-1 in his last five starts after beginning the season 1-2 over his first four starts.
- Daric Barton** (3 for 3, 3 r, 2b, hr, rbi, bb) is hitting .319 (23 for 72) in 24 games since being selected from Triple-A on August 26...the A's have gone 20-4 in games in which he has played since he was selected.
- Coco Crisp** (2 for 4, r, hr, 4 rbi, so) stole his 20th base of the season in the sixth inning...is now the 10th player (13th time) in Athletics history with 20 homers and 20 steals in a season...the last is Ruben Sierra in 1993.

- The Minnesota Twins finished their seven-game road trip to Chicago (1-2) and Oakland (0-4) with a 1-6 record...have lost 14 of their last 18 games dating back to September 4.
- Cole De Vries** started for the first time since September 8, 2012 vs. Cleveland...lasted two innings or fewer in a start for the second time in his career (1.1 ip, August 10, 2012 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Oswaldo Arcia** (3 for 4, r, hr, 6 rbi, bb) recorded a career-high five RBI...leads AL rookies with 33 extra-base hits and 14 home runs.
