TURN ME LOOSE

• Today marks the 114th Opening Day in Cleveland Indians history (1901-2014)...the Tribe is 58-55 (.513) all-time on Opening Day, having lost 4 of 5, 8 of 11, and 10 of the last 15 to kick off the season dating back to 1999 (Tribe won 4 of 5 from 1994-98)...last year's 4-1 win at Toronto snapped a 4-year drought and marked the club's first Opening Day victory since beating the Chicago White Sox 10-8 at Progressive Field to kick off the 2008 campaign.

BACK ON THE STREETS AGAIN

• Although the club opened both the 2011 and 2012 campaigns in Cleveland, this marks the 10th time over the last 13 seasons and the 15th time in the 21-year history of Progressive Field (1994-2014) for the Indians to play their first regular season game on the road...the Tribe went 41-40 (.506) away from Cleveland in 2013, good for the 6th-best road winning pct. in the A.L.

OPENING AGAINST THE ATHLETICS

• Tonight's game marks the third time since the Athletics moved to the Bay Area in 1968 for Cleveland and Oakland to meet on Opening Day (first day of reg. season), with both previous tilts coming in Indians victories here at The Coliseum on April 4, 1983 and April 2, 1997...**ANDRE THORNTON** set the tone in that '83 contest with a 3-run HR in the first inning, helping **RICK SUTCLIFFE** to an 8-5 win; **RICK MANNING** (3-for-5) tallied 3 hits & scored twice...the Tribe opened their '97 AL Championship season with a 9-7 win over the A's, getting a trio of HR's from **KEVIN MITCHELL**, **DAVID JUSTICE** and **JIM THOME**; the 2-run blast by Justice in the 7th proved to be the difference.

In terms of franchise history, the Indians also faced the Athletics on Opening Day three times during their Kansas City years (1955-67), meeting in '58, '59 and '67...see pages 345-349 of Cleveland MG for complete O.D. results and lineups.

OAKLAND STROKE

• The Indians went 5-2 vs. Oakland in 2013, sweeping the A's in a 4-game series at Progressive Field in May before dropping 2 of 3 at the Oakland Coliseum in August...was the Tribe's first of seven 4-game series sweeps last year and first against the A's since '99...Oakland had won 8 straight meetings entering the year...Tribe outscored the A's 33-19 in 2013 play, batting .264, while the pitching staff notched a 2.51 ERA (17 ER/61.0 IP) and limited A's batters to a .216 average against.
• Tribe was MLB-best 25-8 (.758) vs. AL West in 2013, club's highest win pct. vs. A.L. West since '94 realignment.

SEEKING 100 AT THE COLISEUM

• Cleveland will be looking to record the franchise's 100th win all-time here at the Oakland Coliseum, going 99-138 (.418) at this venue since Charlie Finley's A's first called it home in 1968...Tribe is just 13-30 at this park since the start of the 2003 campaign.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

• Cleveland officially announced the club's season-opening 25-man roster on Sunday, breaking spring training camp with 13 pitchers and 12 position players (7 infielders, 4 outfielders, one catcher)...the Indians have turned over 10 of the 25 spots when compared against the club's 2013 Opening Day roster (excluding Scott Kazmir, who was not added to 25-man roster until 5 days into the season).
• While every player on the active 25-man has appeared in the majors at some point in his respective career, the Indians have 4 players on a Major League Opening Day roster for the first time in their careers: **YAN GOMES**, **COREY KLUBER**, **DANNY SALAZAR** and **BLAKE WOOD**.
• Additionally, Cleveland has 6 players seeking to make their debuts in an Indians uniform: **SCOTT ATCHISON**, **JOHN AXFORD**, **JOSH OUTMAN**, **ELLIOT JOHNSON**, **NYJER MORGAN** and **DAVID MURPHY**.

CACTUS LEAGUE RECAP

• The Indians finished Spring Training with the Cactus League's best record at 20-9-2 (.690), just shy of Tampa Bay (.696, 16-7-4) for the best winning pct. in the Majors...Cleveland's offense ranked among Cactus League leaders in OBP (1st, .366), OPS (2nd, .814), AVG (3rd, .288), runs (3rd, 192), SLG (3rd, .449), 2B (4th, 68) and HR (T6th, 29)...the Indians staff registered a 4.28 ERA (132 ER/277.1 IP), 5th-lowest in the Cactus League...staff's 262 strikeouts were 2nd-most in Cactus League & Majors behind only Chicago-NL (268).
• **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** led C.L. w/ .500 AVG (25-50), .552 OBP & 8 doubles (tied) and ranked among leaders w/ 25 hits (T2nd), .740 SLG (5th) & 14 RBI (T7th)...**JASON KIPNIS** ranked among leaders with .446 OBP (7th) and 14 runs (T7th)...**CARLOS SANTANA** was tied for C.L. lead w/ 12 walks...**ASDRUBAL CABRERA**'s .438 OBP ranked 9th...**JUSTIN MASTERSON** had C.L.-low 1.09 ERA (3 ER/24.2 IP) and ranked among leaders with 4 wins (T2nd), 25 K's (T4th) & 24.2 IP (T8th)...**BLAKE WOOD** was tied for C.L. lead w/ 12 appearances.

I WANT TO TAKE YOU HIGHER

• 2013 A.L. Manager of the Year **TERRY FRANCONA** begins his 14th season as a Major League manager, compiling a record of 1121-985 (.532) for Philadelphia (1997-2000), Boston (2004-11) and Cleveland (2013)...Francona's teams are 7-6 all-time on Opening Day: Phillies (2-2), Red Sox (4-4), Indians (1-0), as Tito has been victorious in 4 of 5 and 5 of his last 7 openers.
• The entire 2013 coaching staff returns this season with the addition of Asst. Hitting Coach **MATT QUATRARO** & new bullpen catcher **RICKY PACIONE** (replaces Franklin Morales, now a Double-A hitting coach for SD)...additional changes included: **BRAD MILLS** to Bench Coach, **SANDY ALOMAR** to 1B Coach and **MIKE SARBAUGH** to 3B Coach...collectively, the Cleveland staff brings more than 200 years of experience in professional baseball.

STABILITY AT SHORTSTOP

• Building upon a recent trend of continuity at shortstop for the Indians, **ASDRUBAL CABRERA** is scheduled to make his 5th consecutive Opening Day start at the position and 7th straight overall for the Tribe (started '08 & '09 openers at 2B)...Cabrera would become the 8th player in Cleveland history to make at least 5 consecutive Opening Day starts at shortstop (chart below)...pending Cabrera's inclusion tonight, Indians managers will have used just 3 different shortstops to fill out their Opening Day line-up cards over a 21-year period equivalent to the lifespan of Progressive Field (1994-2014), as **OMAR VIZQUEL** (1994-2004) and **JHONNY PERALTA** (2005-09) round out that trio...Cabrera, who was acquired from Seattle on June 30, 2006, is the 2nd-longest tenured member of the Indians organization behind only **JOSH TOMLIN** (signed on 6/9/06 following draft)...**FRANK HERRMANN** (signed as non-drafted FA on 8/14/05) had been the longest tenured Indians prior to being designated for assignment on Sunday.

Infielder Terry Turner holds the record for most overall Opening Day starts in Cleveland franchise history, starting 14 of 15 Opening Day contests from 1904-18 with an unexplained absence from the 1913 lineup.

THE IDES OF MARCH

• Tonight would mark just the 5th time in franchise history for the Indians to open a season in the month of March, the other instances coming in 1998, 2002, 2003 and 2008...with each taking place on March 31, those are also currently the only 4 instances in Indians history for the team to play a regular season game in this month, going 3-1 in those contests.

DON'T CHANGE HORSES

• Still looking to nail down his first career win here at the Oakland Coliseum, **JUSTIN MASTERSON** is set to become the first Tribe pitcher to start 3 consecutive season openers since southpaw **CC SABATHIA** took the bump for 3 straight from 2006-08 and the first right-hander to do so since **BARTOLO COLON** from 2000-02.
• In 2012, Justin became just the 3rd different right-handed pitcher over a 10-year span (2003-12) to start for the Indians on Opening Day, joining Jake Westbrook (2005, 2010) and Roberto Hernandez (2011).
• Masterson is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (2 ER/14.0 IP) in 2 career Opening Day tilts (5 H, 5 BB, 15 SO).

2013 RECAP

• The Cleveland Indians finished the 2013 campaign with a record of 92-70 (.568) to earn their first Postseason berth since winning an A.L. Central Division title in 2007, which was also club's last season to finish above the .500-mark (96-66)...the Tribe's .568 winning pct. was 4th-highest in the A.L. behind Boston (.599, 97-65), Oakland (.593, 96-66) and Detroit (.574, 93-69) - the 3 respective division-winners - and T7th-highest in the Majors...2013 marked Cleveland's 8th 90-win season since 1995.
• Ignoring the impact of strike-shortened seasons in 1981 and 1994, the Tribe's 24-win increase over 2012 (68-94) matched the largest year-to-year improvement in franchise history, which occurred when Cleveland saw a 24-win jump from 1985 (60-102) to 1986 (84-78).
• Indians reeled off 10 consecutive victories to end the season with their longest winning streak since Aug. 17-27, 2008 (10 straight)...according to research gathered with the help of STATS LLC, Cleveland became just the 6th MLB team in the Modern Era (since 1900) to finish a season with a winning streak of at least 10 games, joining the 1915 White Sox (11), 1937 Pirates (10), 1960 Yankees (15), 1970 Orioles (11) & 1971 Orioles (11).

THIRD CONSECUTIVE OPENING DAY START

- The 29-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 3rd consecutive Opening Day start after being informed of the honor by Terry Francona on March 11
- Masterston is set to become the first Tribe pitcher to start 3 consecutive openers since CC Sabathia took the bump for 3 straight from 2006-08, and the first right-hander to do so since Bartolo Colon from 2000-02
- In 2012, Justin became just the 3rd different right-handed pitcher over a 10-year span (2003-12) to start for the Indians on Opening Day, joining Jake Westbrook (2005, 2010) and Roberto Hernandez (2011)
- Right-handers started 11 straight openers for the Tribe from 1992-2002 (Charles Nagy-4, Dennis Martinez-3, Bartolo Colon-3, Jaret Wright-1), while lefties handled 6 of 9 from 2003-11
- Masterston is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (2 ER/14.0 IP) in his 2 career Opening Day tilts

HISTORIC START

- Defeated reigning NL Cy Young Award winner R.A. Dickey and the Toronto Blue Jays on Opening Day in 2013 (6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 4 BB, 5 SO) before tossing 7.0 scoreless frames of 2-hit ball (3 BB, 8 SO) in a 13-0 SHO victory against 2012 AL Cy Young Award winner David Price and the Tampa Bay Rays in his second start of the campaign
- According to Elias Sports Bureau, Masterston became just the 3rd pitcher in baseball history to record victories against both reigning Cy Young Award winners in the same season (award winners taking loss), but the first to do so in consecutive starts

OUT OF THE GATE

- Through his first 3 starts of 2013 Masterston went 3-0 w/a 0.41 ERA (22.0 IP, 10 H, 1 ER, 20 SO); strung together a then career-high 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings through those starts
- Masterston joined Luis Tiant (1966) as just the 2nd pitcher in Indians history to win his first 3 starts of the season while allowing one or zero combined runs
- Dating back to 1921, Masterston's 0.41 figure stood as the 7th-lowest ERA by any Indians pitcher through his first 3 starts of a season, 4th-lowest by a right-hander

VS. OAKLAND

- Masterston has gone 2-6 with a 8.10 ERA (39 ER/43.1 IP) in 8 career starts against the Athletics; notched 8.0 scoreless relief innings against the A's as a member of the Red Sox from 2008-09
- Pitched at least 7.0 innings in both starts against Oakland in 2013, going 1-0 with a 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP)
- Oakland batters hit just .208 (11-53) in the pair of games vs. Masterston, while his 3.67 SO/BB ratio was his 5th highest vs. any opponent

AT OAKLAND-ALAMEDA COUNTY COLISEUM

- Masterston is 0-5 at the Oakland Coliseum, one of just 3 current American League venues in which he has never registered a victory (Rangers Ballpark in Arlington, 0-2; Yankee Stadium, 0-2)
- Masterston owns a 7.71 ERA (26 ER/30.1 IP) in 6 games/5 starts here in Oakland, while opposing batters have hit .306 (38-124) w/a .914 OPS
- Despite limiting the A's to just 3 runs in his lone start at the Coliseum last season (7.2 IP, 7 H, 3 R-ER, 1 BB, 1 HR, 4 SO), Masterston shouldered the loss as the Tribe dropped a 3-2 decision on August 16.

SPRING TRAINING

- Masterston scattered just 3 earned runs across 24.2 exhibition innings this spring, notching a team-high 4 victories, while registering the lowest ERA (1.09) among all American League hurlers
- Worked 13.0 scoreless innings over 4 starts to start the spring including a hitless 4.0 inning performance on March 11 at Arizona
- Masterston ranked among Cactus League leaders in innings pitched (7th, 24.2), strikeouts (5th, 25), opposing average against (2nd, .171), and WHIP (1st, 0.81)

CAREER SNAPSHOT

- The affable right-hander is in his 7th MLB season (5th full MLB season) since being selected by Boston in the 2nd round (71st overall) of 2006 June draft out of San Diego State University.
- Made MLB debut in 2008 with 9 consec. starts for the Red Sox from April 24-July 5, but spent the rest of the season pitching in relief and went on to play a key role in Boston's bullpen during the ALDS and ALCS.
- Acquired by Cleveland on July 31, 2009, along with LHP Nick Hagadone and RHP Bryan Price, from Boston in exchange for C Victor Martinez.
- First Indians pitcher to log consecutive 200.0-inning campaigns (2011-12) since Cliff Lee (2005-06); Opening Day starter in both 2012 & 2013.
- Became the first 5th ML pitcher over the past 19 seasons (1995-present) to register at least 10 wins and 3 CG SHO's prior to the All-Star Break; the first Indians pitcher to reach those benchmarks since Gaylord Perry in 1974; Masterston was selected, but did not pitch, to his first American League All-Star team for his first half efforts.
- Is the first Jamaican-born pitcher in major league history and just the 4th player from that country overall, joining Chili Davis (1981-99), Devon White (1985-2001) and Rolando Roomes (1988-90).
- Graduated from Beavercreek High School, just east of Dayton, Ohio; attended Bethel College (Mishawaka, IN) in 2004-05 before transferring to SDSU.
