OPENING DAY IN SEATTLE

The Mariners will play their home opener on Tuesday, April 8 hosting the Los Angeles Angels at Safeco Field...Seattle is 22-15 all-time in first home game of the season, including going 7-5 in home openers after starting on the road.

TODAY'S TILT... the Mariners continue their 38th season with a road tilt at the Oakland Athletics... tonight is the final game of a three-game series against the Athletics (1-1)...began the now 6-game road trip with three games against the Angels (3-0)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS** in high definition & broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle & Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...

- Division Rivals Open the season with 16 consecutive games against an AL West foe: LAA 5 G,
 OAK 7 G, TEX 4 G...28 of first 34 games of the 2014 season are against division opponents.
- Road Warriors Mariners will play 23 of first 34 games of the season on the road.
- Fernando Rodney is oldest player on roster (37.017) & Mike Zunino (23.010) the youngest.
- Seattle pitchers have struck out 52 batters in 47.0 innings this year.

ROAD TRIPPIN'...with a win today, the Mariners would complete a 5-1 road trip...would be the first time to win 5 out of 6 on a trip since completing two such trips in 2011 (April 26-May 1 at DET & BOS & May 20-25 at SD & MIN)...since 2002, the Mariners have gone at least 5-1 on a trip six times: 2011 (already mentioned), 2007 (5-1, Aug. 7-12 at BAL & CWS), 2003 (5-1, May 13-18 at CLE & DET and 11-1, May 27-June 8 at KC, MIN, PHI, NYM) and 2002 (10-0, April 8-17 at ANA, TEX & OAK).

LOOKING FOR THE THIRD... the Mariners are looking to take the series today and their third straight in Oakland (went 2-0-1 in 2013)...have not lost a series here since being swept to close out the 2012 season...Seattle has won 4 of the past 5 series (home or road) against the A's dating back to last year.

PITCHING TO PERFECTION...the Mariners have bolstered a 1.91 ERA (10 ER, 47.0 IP) in the first 5 games to open the season...it is the lowest ERA in the first 5 games in a season in club history, destroying the old mark of 2.62 (14 ER, 48.0 IP) in 1993...the Mariners are the first American League team since the 2011 Baltimore Orioles (1.80) to have a sub 2.00 ERA in the first 5 games of the season.

<u>FELIX 2-0</u>...Felix Hernandez is 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA (3 ER, 14.1 IP) in his two starts this season... marks the second time in his 10 Major League seasons to open a season by winning his first two starts...was 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in his first two starts of the 2007 season (0 runs allowed in 17.0 innings vs. the A's and Red Sox).

EXTRA! EXTRA!...Seattle recorded four extra-base hits yesterday and lead the American League and are T2nd in the Majors with 22 extra-base hits (12 2B, 2 3B, 8 HR)...22 of the 47 Mariners hits this season have gone for extra bases.

<u>GRADUATING TO MAJORS</u>...the Mariners have two sets of players who played together in their college days...left-fielder <u>Dustin Ackley</u> and third baseman <u>Kyle Seager</u> played together at the <u>University of North Carolina</u>, and now, shorstop <u>Brad Miller</u> and reliever <u>Dominic Leone</u> are together again after playing together at <u>Clemson University</u>.

WESTERN STREAK...Robinson Cano has a current 13-game hitting streak (since July 24, 2013) against the AL West, hitting .490 (24x49) with 8 runs, 4 doubles, 6 RBI and a .561 on-base percentage... he is a career .309 (364x1178) against the AL West...over his last 19 games at O.Co Coliseum is hitting .342 (27x79) with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs and 11 RBI (since 4/21/10).

EASY AS 1-2-3...the Seattle pitching staff has set a club record by allowing three runs or less in the each of the first five games to start the season...previous record was 3, done three times (1993, 1995, 2000)...the last three teams to start the season with at least 5 games were the 2013 Pirates (5), 2008 Blue Jays and the 2004 Marlins (9).

STARTING THINGS RIGHT... Seattle starters have combined to go 4-0 with a 1.62 ERA (6 ER, 33.1 IP) with 37 K's...opponents are hitting just .169 (20x118) against Mariners starters, 1st in the Majors.

STAYING HOT...dating back to August 7, 2013, **Dustin Ackley** is hitting .319 (51x160) with 19 runs, 9 doubles, 3 triples, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, a .394 OBP, .488 slugging and a .882 OPS in 46 games... his .319 batting average in that span is 10th best in A.L. (min. 100 AB) behind **Robinson Cano** (.375/78x208), **Victor Martinez** (.343/70x204), **Salvador Perez** (.339/59x174), Josh Hamilton (.339 (65x192), **Omar Infante** (.335/60x179), **Craig Gentry** (.330/36x109), **Miguel Cabrera** (.322/58x180), **Dustin Pedroia** (.324/68x210) & **Daniel Nava** (.320/47x147),

FARQUHAR K RATE...Danny Farquhar has struck out 4 of the 10 batters he has faced this season, including 3 in 1.2 innings Thursday night...in his career, Farquhar has recorded strikeout rate of 12.53 per 9.0 innings, the 5th-highest all-time by a pitcher with a minimum of 225 batters faced...Danny has faced 249 batters, and recorded 84 strikeouts...ranks behind Craig Kimbrel (15.12), Aroldis Chapman (14.68), Kenley Jansen (14.06) and Al Alburquerque (12.96).

AS YOU MAY KNOW....catcher Mike Zunino & right-hander Dominic Leone were drafted in 2012 by the Mariners...BUT DID YOU KNOW...that the Mariners are the only team in the Majors with two players on their active roster who were part of the 2012 June Draft class?...the Dodgers are the only team that has had two players from that draft make their Major League debuts (Paco Rodriguez & Onelki Garcia)...Seattle has had at least two players appear in the Majors from each of the 2009-12 drafts...2011: Brad Miller & Carter Capps; 2010: Taijuan Walker, James Paxton & Stephen Pryor; 2009: Dustin Ackley, Nick Franklin, Kyle Seager, Anthony Vasquez & Brandon Bantz.

ABOUT RAMIREZ...

- Pronounced: eh-RAS-moh ruh-MEER-ehz.
- 23-year-old right-hander is making his second start of the season (23rd career MLB start), and 32nd overall appearance today vs. the Athletics.
- Made his Major League debut 4/9/12 in relief at Texas (3.0,2,1,1,1,3,HR)...allowed a solo HR to J. Hamilton.
- Signed by as a non-drafted free agent on 9/1/07. signed by scouts Ubaldo Heredia and Bob Engle.
- Named the 2011 and 2013 Nicaragua Athlete of the Year by the Instituto Nacional de Deportes (Institute of Sport).
- One of 13 players born in Nicaragua to play in MLB (1 of 9 pitchers).
- Named Mariners MiL Pitcher of the Year in 2009 after going 11-1, 0.51 in 14 G (13 GS) with VSL Mariners.
- Recorded first career win on Sept. 11, 2012 at TOR (7.0,6,2,2,1,6).
- On second Opening Day roster in his career (also: 2010), but 2014 is the first in an Opening Day roster as a starter.

LAST TIME OUT...recorded the win in Mariners 8-3 victory on April 1 at Los Angeles-AL...allowed a 2-run home run to Raul Ibanez in the 4th inning, snapping a string of 14.2 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to the Angels...overall allowed 2 runs on 6 hits, while striking out 6 and walking none in 7.0 innings in his 2014 season debut.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP...Ramirez ranked 2nd among qualifying Cactus League pitchers with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER, 23.2 IP)...overall went 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA in 6 games (5 starts) during Spring Training... limited opponents to a .212 (18x85) average, while walking 2 and striking out 20...led all Mariners pitchers with 20 strikeouts.

WALK THIS WAY...Ramirez tossed 7.0 innings without issuing a walk in his last start on April 1 at LAA...marked the second time in his career to toss at least 7.0 innings without allowing a walk (also: 9/18/12 vs. BAL - 8.0,4,2,2,0,6).

VS. DIVISION RIVALS...for his career, **Ramirez** is 2-4 with 2.88 (19 ER, 59.1 IP) in 12 games (9 starts) against AL West opponents, including going 2-1 with a 2.55 ERA (12 ER, 42.1 IP) in divisional rivals home stadiums...his 2.88 ERA is his best against any MLB division.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...Dating back to Aug. 3, 2013, Ramirez is 4-1 with a 3.99 ERA (21 ER, 47.1 IP) in 8 starts on the road, including going 2-0 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER, 25.2 IP) in 4 starts vs. AL West opponents on the road during this stretch...overall as a starter on the road is 5-2 with a 4.08 ERA (32 ER, 70.2 IP) in 12 starts.

AS A STARTER...is 7-6, 4.33 (60 ER, 124.2 IP) in 22 career starts...holds a 2.63 ERA (4 ER, 13.2 IP) in 9 career relief appearances.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER...in 6 minor league seasons, went 44-20 (103 G/97 GS) with a 3.16 ERA (206 ER, 587.2 IP)...has a career strikeout-walk ratio of 4.63 (472 K, 102 BB), and a 1.15 WHIP (walks+hits/innings pitched)...played for the VSL Mariners in 2008 & 2009, going 15-2 in 2 seasons...made US debut with Clinton in 2010 going 10-4 and named the LumberKings Pitcher of the Year.

NICARAGUAN...born 5/2/90 in Rivas, Nicaragua, Ramirez is one of three active MLB players born in Nicaragua...others are Everth Cabrera (SD) and Wilton Lopez (COL)...joins Dennis Martinez (1997) as the only players born in Nicargua to play for the Mariners.

2013 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS.

- Went 5-3 with a 4.98 ERA (40 ER, 72.1 IP) in 14 G/13 GS over two stints with the Mariners last season.
- Averaged 3.24 walks per 9.0 innings (26 BB), compared to his rookie rate of 1.83 BB/9.0 IP in 2012 (12 BB in 59.0 IP).
- Started the season on the minor league disabled list (April 11-May 28) with right triceps tendinitis.
- Pitched for Cardenales de Lara in the Venezuelan Winter League (3-1, 2.86 ERA, 6 GS).

TUESDAY'S STARTER: LHP JAMES PAXTON (1-0, 0.00)

24-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his home debut in the Mariners home opener on Tuesday vs. the Angeles...recorded the win in his season debut on April 2 at LAA (7.0,2,0,0,2,9)...2013 RECAP: went 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (4 ER, 24.0 IP) in 4 starts with the Mariners in 2013...won MLB debut, 6-2 Sept. 7 vs. TB (6.0,4,2,1,1,3,HR)...recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts Sept. 24 vs. Kansas City in fourth career start (7.0,4,0,0,0,10)...his 1.50 ERA was the 2nd-lowest mark for a pitcher in first 4 starts with the Mariners (not necessarily first four career starts)...limited opponents to a .172 (15x87) avg, including .141 (10x71) vs. right-handed batters...spent majority of season with AAA Tacoma, going 8-11 with a 4.45 ERA (70 ER, 145.2 IP) in 28 games/26 starts...led the Rainiers in wins (T1st), starts, innings and strikeouts...tossed the squad's only complete games (2) and only shutout...MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER: Is 23-18, 3.45 (133 ER, 347.0 IP) in 66 games (64 starts) since 2011 with Mariners affiliates in Clinton, Jackson and Tacoma...was drafted by Seattle in the 4th round of the 2010 draft...attended the University of Kentucky from 2007-09...previously was selected in the first round of the 2009 June draft by Toronto, but did not sign...VS. ANGELS: Making his second career start vs. the Angels, after winning his debut in his first start vs. LAA on April 2.
