#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics scored seven runs in the first inning, the most of any MLB team this year in any inning...hit a season-high four home runs, the most since Sept. 4, 2013...are 9-2 over the last 11 games...are the only team in the majors that has not lost back-to-back games this season.
- Sonny Gray extended his winning streak to six games dating back to Sept. 11 of last year, an on-going career-high...allowed a career-high nine hits (previous: 8, Aug. 25, 2013).
- Coco Crisp (2 for 3, hr, 2 rbi, bb) committed a fielding error in the fifth inning...that snapped a 145-game errorless streak, which was fifth longest in Oakland history by an outfielder.
- · Yoenis Céspedes (3 for 4, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi, bb, so) has a 13-game hitting streak against Houston dating back to May 24 of last year.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 3, r, 2 bb) snapped a 10-game hitting streak, the second-longest of his career (11, Sept. 3-15, 2013).
- Josh Reddick (3 for 4, r, hr, 2 rbi) hit a two-run home run in the first inning...the home run snapped an 11-game streak in which he had not recorded an extra base hit...that was the second longest such streak of his career (13, Aug. 11-25, 2013).

#### **HOUSTON NOTES**

- The Houston Astros are on a five-game losing streak, which is their longest losing streak of the season.
- Jarred Cosart tossed 0.1 innings, which is the shortest start of his career (previous: 4.0 ip, Sept. 3, 2013 vs. MIN)...is first pitcher in 2014 to go 0.1 innings or fewer in a start...allowed a career-high seven runs (previous: 5, Apr. 7, 2014 vs. LAA)...had allowed just one earned run in 13.0 career innings (0.69 ERA) against Oakland.
- · Matt Dominguez (0 for 4, so) snapped a seven-game hitting streak, which was the longest of his career.
- Dexter Fowler (2 for 4, r, rbi, bb) snapped an 0 for 15 hitless streak with an RBI single in the 5th inning.
