OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** now lead the all-time series against Houston 22-5, the best record by a Major League club against another club among teams that have played each other 20 or more times...are 10-2 over the last 12 games.
- Josh Reddick (3 for 5, rbi)** hit his fourth career walk-off RBI.
- This is the Oakland Athletics second walk-off win of the season (previous: April 3 vs. Seattle)
- The Athletics left 14 runners on base, a new season-high.
- Daric Barton (1 for 3, r, 2b, so)** snapped an 0 for 11 streak with a double in the third inning.
- Yoenis Céspedes (2 for 4, r, bb)** has a 14-game hitting streak against Houston dating back to May 24 of last year.
- Craig Gentry (2 for 3, 2b, rbi)** has hit safely in each of his four starts since starting the season on the DL.

HOUSTON NOTES

- The Houston Astros are on a six-game losing streak, the longest of their season.
- Brett Oberholtzer** has lasted 5.0 or more innings in each of his first 13 career Major League starts, which ties a franchise record.
- Chris Carter (1 for 2, r, 2b)** ended an 0 for 14 streak with a double in the fourth inning...has gone 23 consecutive games without homering (previous: Sept. 23, 2013), the longest streak of his career.
- George Springer (1 for 4, 2b, so)** collected a hit for his fourth-consecutive game...is first Astro to record hits in first four Major League games since 2011.
- Jose Altuve (1 for 4, 2 sb)** recorded two stolen bases, his sixth career game of two or more steals.
- Jonathan Villar (2 for 3, 2 r, hr, rbi)** is the first Astros shortstop with at least 2 extra-base hits, 2 runs scored and a stolen base in the same game since Miguel Tejada did so (Apr. 21, 2008)
