THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY: April 20

2005 - A 1st-inning homer by Craig Biggio gives him his 1,000th career RBI in a 6-1 win over the Brewers... Biggio also records his 399th career stolen base in the win.

1997 - Craig Biggio's two homers provide all the offense for the Astros in a 3-1 win at Dodger Stadium... his solo home run early in the game gives the Astros a 1-0 lead, and his two-run homer in the 8th snaps a 1-1 tie to win it.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Today's game marks the third of a six-game, west coast road trip for the Astros as they take on the A's in Oakland (Fri-Sun) and the Mariners in Seattle (Mon-Wed).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros are in the midst of a stretch that will see them play 12 of 15 games on the road between April 8-23...the club recently had a quick, three-game home series against the Royals that came after a six-game road trip in Toronto (1-2) and Texas (1-2).

TODAY'S GAME: RHP Brad Peacock (0-1) will make his first start of the season and will face his former organization as he takes the hill opposite RHP Jesse Chavez (0-0)...has made three career starts against the Athletics...in his last start against the club on 9/5/13, tossed 7.0 innings while allowing two runs and striking out nine in an Astros 3-2 win at the Coliseum...Houston has not beaten the A's since that game.

PEACOCKIN': Today's starter RHP Brad Peacock has fared much better as a starting pitcher in his MLB career...has pitched out of the bullpen this year for Houston, but finished up the 2013 season in the Astros rotation and had solid results...in his last nine starts, went 4-3 with a 3.64 ERA (22ER/54.1IP) and 54 strikeouts...owns a 4.38 ERA (42ER/86.1IP) in 16 career Major League starting assignments.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros dropped their sixth straight game yesterday, falling to Oakland by a score of 4-3...starter LHP Brett Oberholtzer (1ER/5.2IP) pitched well but the Astros could not hold on to a two-run lead in the 9th inning as RHP Chad Qualls (3ER/0.1IP) received his first blown save of the year...SS Jonathan Villar (2x3, HR, RBI) hit a solo homer and scored two runs while 2B Jose Altuve (1x4) had a pair of steals...RF George Springer (1x4) recorded his first career extra-base hit, a double.

V6 HEATING UP: Yesterday SS Jonathan Villar became the first Astros shortstop to record at least two extra-base hits, two runs scored and a stolen base in the same game since Miguel Tejada did so on 4/21/08...Villar ranks second among all AL shortstops in slugging (.442) and tied for second in homers (3) this season.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: With his start yesterday, Oberholtzer has now lasted 5.0 or more innings in each of his first 14 career Major League starts, which ties a franchise record...RHP Mark Lemongello also went 5.0+ innings in each of his first 14 Major League starts from 1976-77...Oberholtzer's streak is the longest by a left-handed pitcher in franchise history.

STANDING TALL: 2B Jose Altuve has not made an error in his last 53 games and 248 total chances (last error was on 8/16/13 at LAA)... since 7/9/13, he has made just one error in 81 games and 377 TC for a .997 fielding percentage, which is tops in the Majors in that span among second basemen.

THE MAGIC NUMBER FOUR: The Astros are 4-1 when they score four or more runs this season.

STEADY UP THE MIDDLE: Among qualifying players, 2B Jose Altuve and SS Jonathan Villar are the only second base-shortstop combo in the Majors this season that has not committed an error (164 combined total chances).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: After getting selected from Triple A on Wednesday, OF George Springer has hit in each of his first four Major League games...the last Astro to record hits in his first four MLB contests was Jose Altuve, who hit in his first seven Major League games after debuting in 2011.

CATCHING ON: Since 2013, Castro Valley, CA-native and Stanford grad Jason Castro leads all MLB catchers in slugging (.515) and on-base percentage (.362)...ranks third in home runs (19) among AL catchers over that span...his OPS as a catcher is .877 since 2013.

CHARTING THE HITS: Jose Altuve currently ranks tied for first among American League second basemen in hits.

GOING BACK TO CALI: The Astros are 5-22 all-time vs. the A's...they are looking for their first win against the club since 9/5/13 at OAK.

CLOSE CALLS: Seven of the Astros last nine games have been decided by two runs or less (four one-run contests)...they are 2-5 in those games.

GOIN' DEEP: The Astros are fourth in the AL in HR with 19...they are 5-5 in games that they homer in this season, and 0-8 when they do not homer.

THROWING SOME LEATHER: As a club, the Astros rank second in the Majors in fielding percentage with a .991 mark (6 E, 705 TC).

GROUND CONTROL: The Astros pitching staff ranks first in the AL and third in the Majors in ground ball to fly ball ratio with a 1.85 mark... Jarred Cosart (2.43), Dallas Keuchel (2.29) and Scott Feldman (2.14) all rank among the AL's top 10 pitchers in GB/FB ratio...since 1987 (the year the stat was first tracked), the Astros have never had more than two starters post groundball to fly ball ratios higher than 2.00 for a full season.

YOUNGBLOODS: Houston currently has the youngest roster in the Majors at 27.2 years old... they are followed by MIA (27.4) and ATL (27.4).

LAST NIGHT IN THE MINORS: At Triple A Oklahoma City, 1B Jon Singleton (1x4, HR, 3RBI) homered for the second consecutive game and LHP Rudy Owens (0ER/5.0IP) tossed 5.0 hitless innings...Singleton has homered in three of his last four games and has six homers in his last 10...he leads the Pacific Coast League and ranks tied for second in all of the minor leagues with seven homers this season...in Lancaster, SS Carlos Correa went 3x3 with a double and a triple while starter RHP Vincent Velasquez (0ER/5.0IP) struck out four over 5.0 innings of one-hit ball... Velasquez leads the California League in wins (4-0) and ranks second in ERA (1.29).

LAST APPEARANCE - 4/16 vs. KC (in relief): made his 4th appearance of the season in relief on Wed. vs. KC...allowed 2 runs on 2 hits in 0.2 of an inning in the Astros 6-4 loss.

PEACOCKIN': will be making his 1st turn in the rotation today after beginning the year in the bullpen...is taking the rotation spot of the DFA'd RHP Lucas Harrell

- was 1 of 4 pitchers vying for the final 2 spots in the rotation this Spring, along with LHP Dallas Keuchel, RHP Jerome Williams and Harrell.
- in his 4 relief appearances this year, reached a maximum of 3.1 innings and 63 pitches both coming on 4/3 vs. NYY (1ER/3.1IP)... since then, his appearances have been 3.0 IP, 2.2 IP and 0.2 of an inning last Wednesday.

FOR STARTERS: has been much more effective as a starter in his career, posting a 7-6 record and a 4.38 ERA (42ER/86.1IP) in 16 games.

- finished his 2013 campaign in the rotation by posting a 4-3 record and a 3.64 ERA (22ER/54.1IP) in his final 9 starts...those starts all came after a return from a 2-month stint in the minors.

THIS SPRING: had 4 appearances during Spring Training and gave up 6 runs in 8.1 innings (6.48 ERA) with 8 strikeouts and 2 walks...aside from his first outing of the Spring (5ER/1IP), posted a 1.23 ERA over his final 3 games (1ER/7.1IP).

IN 2013: began the 2013 season as the Astros No. 4 starter but was moved to the bullpen and optioned to Triple A twice before sticking in the Majors at the beginning of August.

- during his final stint at Triple A Oklahoma City (June 13-July 29), saw solid results, going 5-0 with a 1.88 ERA (12ER/57.1IP) over 10 outings (nine starts)...moved back into the Astros rotation after getting recalled on Aug. 4.

vs OAK: is starting against his former club for the 4th time in his career today...lasted just 4.1 innings in his 1st 2 starts opposite the A's last year before earning a win on 9/5/13 at OAK (2ER/7IP).

FORMER A'S: was acquired by Houston from Oakland along with **IF/OF Chris Carter** and minor league **C Max Stassi** on Feb. 2 in exchange for **IF Jed Lowrie**...was the top pitching prospect in the A's minor league system at the time of the trade, according to *Baseball America*.

ROAD TO THE MAJORS: drafted by Washington as a "draft and follow" after his senior season in the 41st round of the June 2006 draft, but did not sign immediately... elected to attend Palm Beach Community College (currently known as Palm Beach State College), where he went 8-2 with 82 strikeouts in 75 innings with the PBCC Panthers...signed by Washington following that season.

- dealt from Washington to Oakland on 12/23/11 as part of the return on the Gio Gonzalez trade to the Nationals.

LAST START - 4/16 vs. KC: tossed his 2nd consecutive quality start, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing 2 runs on 6 hits...left the game with a 4-2 lead and in line for the win...the bullpen couldn't hold and the Astros lost the game 6-4 in 11 innings, while Keuchel ended up with a no decision.

ABOUT KEUCHEL: 26-year old lefty made his Major League debut on an Opening Day roster this season...last year, was originally assigned to Triple A at the onset of the season, but was recalled before making an appearance.

GROUND CONTROL: since 2013, ranks 3rd in the Majors in groundball to flyball ratio (2.54) behind RHP A.J. Burnett (2.68) and RHP Garrett Richards (2.68).

THIS SPRING: entered Spring Training as a candidate for 1 of the final 2 spots in the rotation...began his Spring by tossing 9.0 scoreless innings across his 1st 3 starts...all 6 of his Spring starts came in road games.

IN 2013: pitched in 31 games for Houston, making 22 starts...fared much better as a starter, posting a 6-8 record and a 4.90 ERA (72ER/132.1IP) as opposed to his nine relief appearances (0-2, 6.75)...owned a tie for the club lead with 153.2 innings pitched (also, Harrell).

vs. SEA: has been solid in all 3 of his career appearances (2 starts) against Seattle, which all came in 2013...recorded quality starts in both starts, but was handed the loss in both appearances.

- last pitched opposite the Mariners on 8/31 in Houston, tossing 7.0 innings and allowing 3 runs on 4 hits...the Astros dropped that game 3-1.
