WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers begin a 6-game, 7-day road trip to Oakland (3 G) and Seattle (3 G) tonight in Oakland...finished 7-3 on 10-game, 10-day homestand against Houston (2-1), Seattle (3-1), and Chicago-AL (2-1) preceding this trip...yesterday's loss snapped season-high 5-game win streak, tied for longest by any A.L. club in 2014 and T2nd-longest in MLB...have won 5 of 6 and 6 of last 8 since a 5-6 start...at 11-8 (.579), club's record is T3rd-best in the A.L., while 11 wins are T2nd-most in the league...there are 6 A.L. teams over .500 entering play today...longest losing streak was 2 games (April 4-5)...club was 13-6 through 19 G in 2013, and lost the next game...current 11-8 start is fewest wins thru 19 G since 2010 (8-11)...team enters tonight 2.5 GB of division-leading Oakland losing ground in the division for first time yesterday since loss on Monday vs. Seattle...team is in sole possession of 2nd place in the A.L. West for a 5th straight day.

PRINCE'S FREE PASSES: Prince Fielder is the first player in American League history with as many as 8 IBB in the month of April according to Elias Sports Bureau...Fielder's 8 IBB lead the majors, 3 more than the next-closest player (MIA's Giancarlo Stanton-5) and 5 more than any other MLB player outside of Stanton...all 8 IBB came during the club's just-completed 10-game homestand...several A.L. players have had as many as 8 IBB in a month recently, but Fielder is the first to do it in April.

• The 8 IBB are a Rangers club record for any month (previously 7 by Juan Gonzalez in July 1996), but still shy of the Washington/Texas franchise mark for a month...the Senators' Frank Howard had 10 IBB in July 1970 and 9 IBB in July 1969 (credit Elias).

<u>I'M THE MAN:</u> Yu Darvish makes his 4th start of the season tonight, seeking his first win against the A's in nearly 2 years and his first win ever at the Coliseum (0-2 in 2 starts)...Darvish has allowed 2-runs-or-less in 8 consecutive starts dating to last year, going 2-2, 1.73 (10 ER/52.0 IP) since 9/9/13 w/ 18 BB and 60 K's...the only other MLB pitchers with active streaks of qualifying starts allowing 2-R-or-less are Dodgers' Zack Greinke (16) and Padres' Andrew Cashner (9)...Darvish's 521 K's are the most in the majors since the start of 2012...he is 1-6 with a 4.30 ERA (21 ER/44.0 IP) in 7 career starts vs. Oakland, including 0-4 in 4 starts in 2013 (2 1-0 defeats)...has gone 0-6 with a 4.95 ERA (20 ER/36.1 IP) in his last 6 starts against the A's.

NOT CLOSE: The Rangers lost by 14 runs yesterday to the White Sox, allowing season highs for runs (16) and hits (18)...pitchers also managed a season-high 12 K's...the 16-2 defeat marked the largest for the Rangers since a 19-2 loss on July 3, 2012 at Chicago-AL, as club's only losses by 14+ runs in the last 13 seasons (2002-14) have come to the White Sox... yesterday was the Rangers' worst home loss since Aug. 23, 1999 vs. NYY (21-3) and just the 5th loss by 14+ runs ever at Globe Life Park.

- It was the 2nd-largest loss in the majors this season to only the Yankees'
   16-1 loss in Tampa Bay on Saturday.
- Texas was held to 2 hits yesterday, fewest hits in a game since July 28, 2013 at CLE (2 H)...team had as many as 10 times on base with 2-hits-or-less for first time since 6/12/91 vs. CWS.
- Hector Noesi allowed 7 runs in the 9th yesterday, most allowed in an inning by a Texas reliever since Yoshinori Tateyama on 5/30/12 vs. SEA (8 R 3rd inn.)...last Texas pitcher to allow at least 7 runs in the 9th-or-later was Brandon Villafuerte on 8/8/01 vs. DET (also 7 R).

**KOUZMANOFF SELECTED A.L. PLAYER OF WEEK:** Rangers 3B Kevin Kouzmanoff has been selected the American League Player of the Week after batting .345 (10-29) with 2 HR, 4 doubles, and 8 RBI in 7 G...only Rangers win win the weekly award last year were Adrian Beltre (July 7) and Alex Rios (Sept. 29).

**PARRINO CLAIMED BY A'S:** INF Andy Parrino, DFA'd by Texas on Fri., 4/18, was sent to Oakland today on a waiver claim (optioned to Sacramento).

<u>LUIS SARDINAS</u> made his major league debut yesterday and singled in his first ML plate appearance (first pitch) after entering the game as a defensive replacement...he is the first Ranger with a hit in his first major league plate appearance in 2014, joining a pair of rookies to do it last year: Engel Beltre on 6/27 at NYY and Jim Adduci on 9/1 vs. MIN...he joined RHP's Seth Rosin and Nick Martinez as players to make their ML debut with Texas this season.

- Sardinas (20 years, 339 days old yesterday) is currently the youngest player to appear in an MLB game this season...joins a short list of Rangers with hits in the ML debuts before the age of 21 (he is the 7th)...the list (by age): Jurickson Profar (19.195), Ivan Rodriguez (19.205), Sammy Sosa (20.216), Elvis Andrus (20.223), Ruben Sierra (20.238), Roy Howell (20.265).
- Sardinas is the 3rd Ranger position player to make his debut at 20-or-younger since 2009 (also Andrus, Profar)...all other MLB teams have combined for 11 such players in that span, and no other club has as many as 3.

PLEASE HAMMER, DON'T HURT 'EM: Through last night, the Rangers lead the majors in both total disabled list uses this season (11) and current players on the DL (10)...Texas has 5 players on both the 15- and 60-day DL lists.

**ON THE ROAD:** Rangers went 2-4 on first road trip of the year to TB (1-2) and BOS (1-2)...2 of the 4 losses on that trip came with Rangers holding a lead in the 8th inning, only to see the home team score multiple runs in the bottom of the 8th for the last at-bat win.

VS. OAKLAND: The Rangers and A's begin a 3-game series tonight at the Coliseum, first of 19 scheduled meetings in 2014...Texas plays Oakland in 6 of next 9 (also in Arlington, April 28-30), and then do not meet again until June 16-18 back here in Oakland...Rangers have finished 2nd to A's in the A.L. West in 2 straight years, going a combined 17-21 against Oakland in those 2 campaigns...lost season series last year, 9-10, by dropping final 4 meetings and 6 of last 8 contests, including suffering 3-G sweep Sept. 13-15 in Arlington...Rangers have a 30-27 overall edge since 2011...going back to September 2010, Rangers have gone 5-4-1 in last 10 series at the Coliseum, including taking 2 of 3 series here in 2013...team has gone .500-or-better in Oakland in 3 of last 4 years, 5-4 last year...Rangers lead all-time series 324-313, and A's have 167-151 edge in Oakland.

**VS. A.L. WEST:** Texas enters this 3-game series with a 5-2 record against A.L. West clubs in 2014...team is in a span in which 19 of 22 are against West opponents through May 4, and club is 3-1 so far in that stretch... Rangers have gone 58-25 (.699) in division games since the start of last year (53-23 in 2013), easily the best record by any MLB team against division foes in that span.

# **TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER**

# #11 Yu Darvish, RHP (1-0, 0.82)

**TONIGHT:** The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 4th start of the season in tonight's series and road trip opener at the Coliseum...has allowed 2 runs in 22.0 innings over his first 2 starts, yet is 1-0 with 2 no decisions...team has gone 3-0 in his starts...has yet to throw a pitch this season with any Texas runs on the scoreboard, as his only 2 runs of support came in the top half of an inning before Darvish gave way to a reliever...took no decision in last start on Wed. vs. SEA, matchup with Felix Hernandez...has allowed 2-runs-or-less in 8 consecutive starts dating to last year, going 2-2, 1.73 (10 ER/52.0 IP) since 9/9/13 w/ 18 BB and 60 K's...opened season on DL with neck stiffness, but started Rangers' 6th game of the year...Darvish's 521 K's are the most in the majors since the start of 2012...owns the 2nd highest career winning percentage at .625 (30-18) for a Texas starter with 50+ starts, behind Aaron Sele at .649 (37-20).

**LEAGUE LEADER:** Leads 2nd among A.L. qualifiers with a 0.82 ERA...ranks 5th in A.L. with 0.86 WHIP and is T8th in league with a .185 opp. avg. (also NYY's Masahiro Tanaka).

LAST START: Took a no decision in Rangers' 3-2 walkoff win on Wed. vs. SEA (7.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R-ER, 2 BB, 8 SO, 0 HR, 107 pitches/66 strikes)...was 3rd career matchup with Felix Hernandez (who also took a ND), first since his rookie season in 2012...both runs scored in the 2nd inning on back-to-back RBI singles from Mike Zunino and Abraham Almonte, snapping season-opening 16-inning scoreless streak...retired 16 of final 20 batters faced after the Almonte single, and 11 of last 12...Rangers won despite trailing by one with 2 outs and nobody on in the 9th, a pair of unearned runs against Fernando Rodney...Darvish is now winless in career-high 8 straight starts in Arlington...the game marked 7th time since the start of 2013 for Darvish to go winless in a start of 7.0+ innings while allowing 2-runs-or-less.

VS. OAKLAND: Is 1-6, 4.30 (21 ER/44.0 IP) in 7 career starts vs. OAK, including 0-4, 4.13 (11 ER/24.0 IP) in 4 starts in 2013 with a pair of 1-0 defeats...has multiple losses against just 3 MLB clubs: OAK (1-6), SEA (3-3), and CLE (0-2)... won first career start vs. A's on 5/16/12 in Arlington (4-1 Texas win - 7.2 IP, 1 R-ER), but is 0-6, 4.95 (20 ER/36.1 IP) in his last 6 starts, with Rangers scoring 2-runs-or-less in 5 of those 6 defeats...lost 1-0 in last meeting w/ OAK on 9/14/13 in Arlington (7.0 IP, 1 R-ER)...has lost both career starts at the Coliseum, going 0-2, 9.58 (11 ER/10.1 IP), allowing at least 5 runs in both outings...last pitched here on 9/4/13, an 11-4 Texas loss (5.0 IP, 5 H, 5 R-ER)...this is one of 3 opposing parks in which he has multiple losses: Safeco (0-3), Progressive (0-2), and the Coliseum (0-2).

ON ROAD: Tossed 7.0 shutout innings for his lone win of the year in his only road start on 4/6 at TB...last 6 road starts dating back to 8/6/13: 4-1, 3.00 (13 ER/39.0 IP)...went 6-3, 3.05 (29 ER/85.2 IP) in 13 starts on road last year...in his career, is 13-10, 3.39 (72 ER/191.1 IP) in 29 career road starts, with opponents batting .202.

**2014:** Team is 3-0 in his starts...Arencibia (0 ER/14.0 IP) started first 2 outings behind plate, Chirinos (2 ER/8.0 IP) started most recent and also entered defensively in Darvish's 2nd start...lefties are hitting just .164 (9-55)...has seen just 3 different 3-0 counts in '14...opponents are 2-for-20 with RISP...had season-opening 16.0-inning scoreless streak and has allowed runs in just one of his 22 innings this year...has matched up with Alex Cobb, Scott Feldman, and Felix Hernandez in his first 3 starts...had at least 7.0 scoreless innings in each of his first 2 starts to begin the year, the first A.L. pitcher with 2 such starts (in April) since Felix Hernandez in 2007.

OTHER STARTS: Threw 7.0 scoreless innings in season debut on 4/6 at TB after being activated from DL prior to the game (W, 7.0 SHO IP)...a scoreless game thru 7 innings, Texas won 3-0 after Andrus' 2-run HR in the 8th...took ND in Rangers' 1-0, 12-inning win on 4/11 vs. HOU (8.0 SHO IP)...became just 3rd MLB pitcher since start of 2012 to allow one-or-zero hits in at least 8.0 SHO IP and not earn the win.

**DISABLED LIST:** Was placed on the 15-day disabled list March 30, retroactive to March 21, with neck stiffness...pitched March 16 vs. CWS and was scratched from his next scheduled outing on March 21 due to the neck stiffness...was scratched from his scheduled Opening Day start on March 25 and was examined in Texas by Dr. Drew Dossett...an MRI and Dr. Dossett's evaluation indicated that there were no structural issues and no injection was required...he resumed a throwing program in the next few days and threw an 86-pitch bullpen session in Arlington on April 1...working with pitching coach Mike Maddux, he did a simulated session that was the equivalent of 4.0 innings...it was the 2nd DL stint of his ML career (also July 7-22, 2013 - right trapezius strain).

MR. 500: Recorded his 500th career strikeout with a punchout of Wil Myers in the 1st inning April 6 at TB to become the 2nd-fastest pitcher in ML history (62 games) to accomplish the feat (since 1914), behind Dwight Gooden, who did it in

his 61st career game...<u>reached 500 K's in his 402nd career inning, quickest by a starter in ML history</u>...Darvish's 504 K's are the most in the majors since the start of 2012...donated his cap from that game to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in Cooperstown.

PUNCH OUT LIST: Has 20 career games of 10+ strikeouts, 3rd most in Rangers history behind Ryan (34) and Witt (24)...in 2013 had 5 starts with 14 or more strikeouts, most in a single season in Rangers history (Ryan, 3 in 1990) with all other ML pitchers having a total of 4 G of 14+ K's...fanned a career-high 15 on Aug. 12 at HOU, the 2nd-highest total in majors in 2013 (DET's Anibal Sanchez-17 K's, April 26 vs. ATL) and one shy of the club record (twice by Ryan)... had 4 starts of 14+ K's and one-or-zero walks, just the 3rd pitcher since 1920 to accomplish that feat (Pedro Martinez, 5 in 1999; Randy Johnson, 4 in 1999)... owns 5 of the 15 games of 14+ strikeouts in club history, 2nd to Ryan's 7...had a major league high 12 games of 10+ SO in 2013, 2nd-most team annals (Ryan, 18 in 1989)...recorded 10-or-more strikeouts a major league best 8 times in 2012... was 3rd ML pitcher since 1918 with at least 8 games of 10+ K's in 1st 24 career games (Nomo/Gooden-10 each)...registered at least one strikeout in 14 consecutive innings pitched, June 20-July 1, 2012, the longest streak by a Ranger since Ugueth Urbina (14, June 18-July 9, 2003).

# TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP NICK MARTINEZ (0-0, 4.50)

The 23-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 2nd major league start in the middle contest of this 3-game set in Oakland on Tuesday night...is expected to be recalled from Double-A Frisco, where he has no record and a 1.86 ERA (2 ER/9.2 IP) in 2 starts...will be working on regular 4-days' rest after taking a no decision in Frisco's 3-2 win over Corpus Christi on Thursday (4.2 IP, 3 H, 1 R-ER, 5 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR, 98 pitches/60 strikes)...made major league debut in the Rangers'5-4 loss on April 5 at Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R-ER, 3 BB, 3 SO, 2 HR, 85 pitches/49 strikes)...matched up with David Price and left the game with a 4-3 lead and in line for his first major league win...
