- The Oakland Athletics were shutout for the second time this season...were swept in a home series for the first time since September 3-5, 2012 against Los Angeles (AL).
- Sonny Gray had his six-game winning streak dating back to September 11 of last year snapped...allowed his first home run of the season in the sixth inning.
 Alberto Callaspo (0 for 3 gidp) went 4 for 25 (160) on the homestand and is now batting 200 (6 for 30) in Oakland compared to 351 (13 for 37) on the
- Alberto Callaspo (0 for 3, gidp) went 4 for 25 (.160) on the homestand and is now batting .200 (6 for 30) in Oakland compared to .351 (13 for 37) on the road.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 3, 2b, bb, gidp) has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games (23 for 71, .324) after going 2 for 22 (.091) over his first five contests.
- Jed Lowrie (1 for 4) is 11 for 35 (.314) with five doubles, a home run and seven runs scored in his last eight games after going 2 for 18 (.111) over his previous seven contests.
- Derek Norris (1 for 2, bb) is 7 for 19 (.368) during the day compared to 4 for 20 (.200) at night.

- Martin Perez tossed his second consecutive complete game shutout... extended his scoreless innings streak to a career-high 26.0 innings...is the first Rangers pitcher with more than two consecutive scoreless starts in a season since Kenny Rogers tossed four consecutive scoreless starts (30.0 ip, April 27- May 14, 2005).
- Elvis Andrus (0 for 4, bb, so) has reached base safely via hit or walk in 21 of 22 games.
- Michael Choice (1 for 4, r, rbi, bb, so) has hit safely in his last five starts...went 3 for 8 (.375) in the series and is 7 for 21 (.333) over his last 11 games.
- Donnie Murphy (1 for 3, r, hr) went 3 for 7 (.429) with 2 RBI in the series.
